Our records show that certificate of water right recorded at Page 14118, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, has been issued to Harley B. Hall for the use of 0.01 cubic foot of water per second from two springs for domestic supplies for two families. The place of use is within Lot 1 $(SW_4^1 SW_4^1)$ of Section 27, Township 16 South, Range 2 East, W.M. and the priority date is March 30, 1936.

Although the map used to support Mr. Hall's application for a permit to appropriate water shows three springs and three houses on the north side of the highway, the map made in connection with the final proof survey shows two springs north of the highway and on the lands described in the legal description you submitted, but the place of use for the two families is on the south side of the highway.

This is the only right of record shown with a source of water from springs in this area.
