Dear Mr. Leonard:

Our records show that certificate of water right recorded at Page 14118, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, has been issued to Harley B. Hall for the use of 0.01 cubic foot of water per second from two springs for domestic supplies for two families. The place of use is within Lot 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 27, Township 16 South, Range 2 East, W.M. and the priority date is March 30, 1936.

Although the map used to support Mr. Hall's application for a permit to appropriate water shows three springs and three houses on the north side of the highway, the map made in connection with the final proof survey shows two springs north of the highway and on the lands described in the legal description you submitted, but the place of use for the two families is on the south side of the highway.

This is the only right of record shown with a source of water from springs in this area.

A perfected water right, such as the above mentioned certificate, remains valid indefinitely provided the water is used as described on the certificate. It is subject to forfeiture by failure to exercise the right for a period of five successive years.

Copies of the certificate and supporting map are available upon request and on receipt of the \$1.10 copying fee.



In reply to your letter of October 14th, this will advise you that if you have used all of the water described in your Permit No. 12080, namely, 0.01 second-foot which is equivalent to $4\frac{1}{2}$ gallons per minute for domestic use and the irrigation of a domestic garden, you are entitled to make final proof and receive a certificate of water right covering such use. The fact that you may later improve or replace your distribution system would not alter the situation.

If the water was put to the use specified on or before October 1, 1939, you should so report to this office by filling out and submitting the enclosed forms. After their receipt, a representative of this office will, on his next inspection trip, make a check of the amount of water used by you, the location, etc., preparatory to final proof.

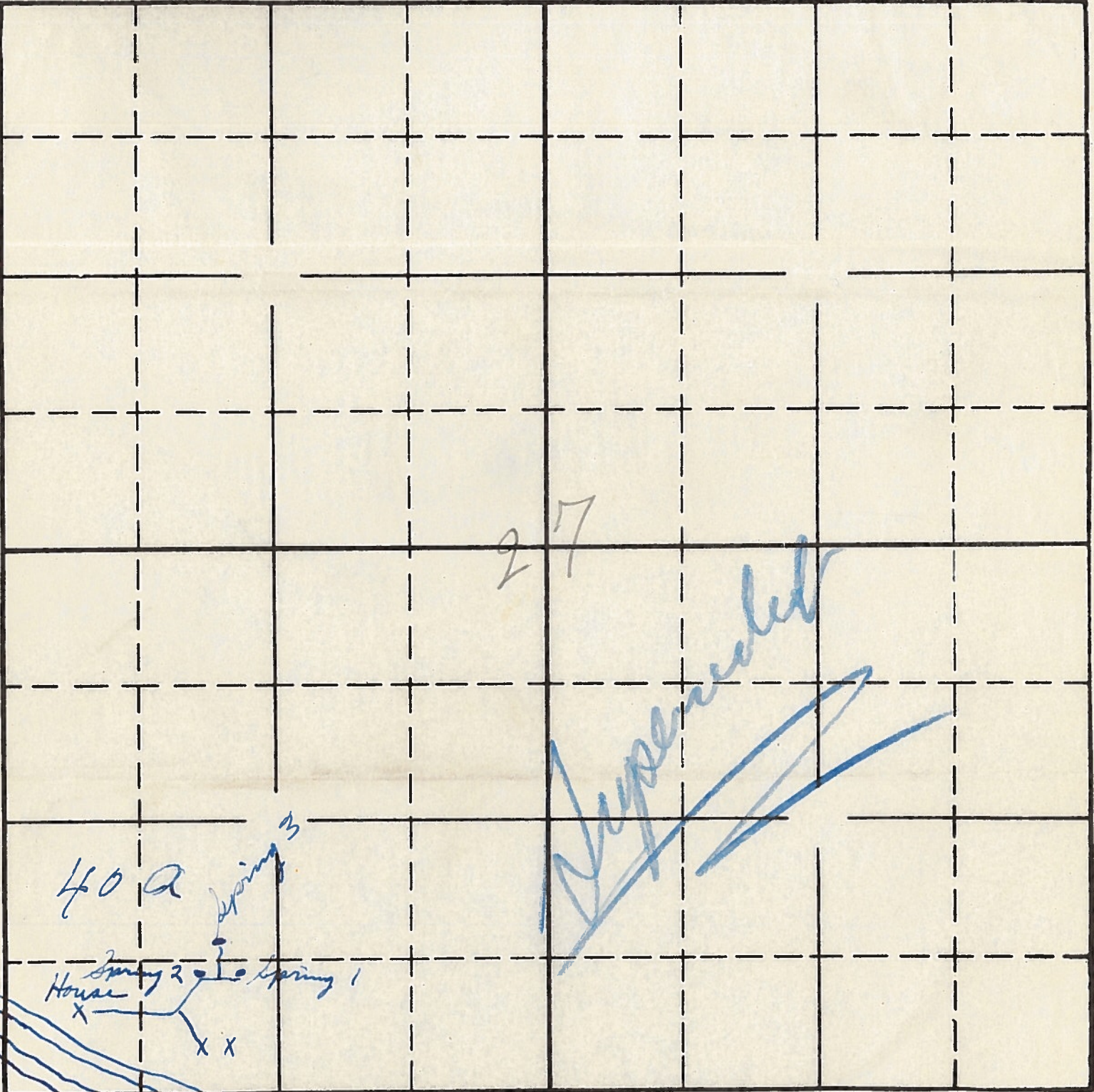
