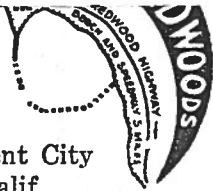

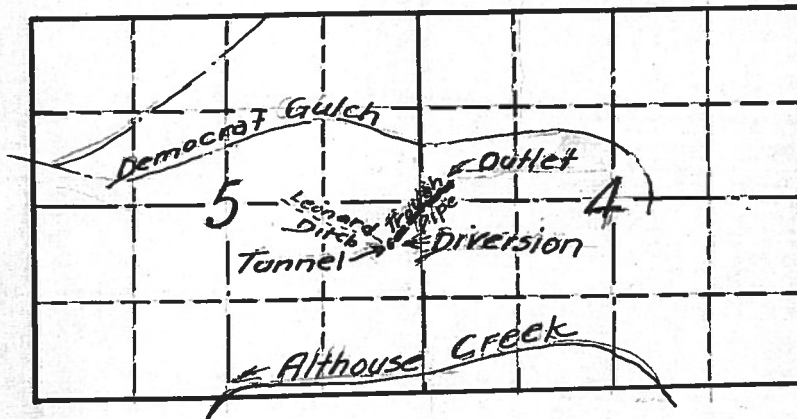

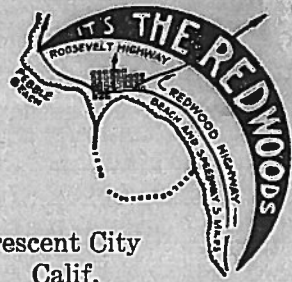

I wish to add my recommendation of Mr. E. L. Kendall, of Crescent City, to the enclosed report and request from him to you.

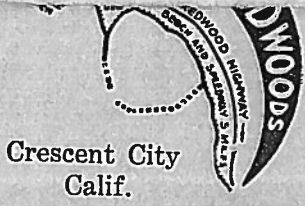

NOTICE OF BEGINNING OF CONSTRUCTION

I, Edward L. Kendall, the holder of Application No. 12231, being Reservoir and enlargement Permit No. 8622, issued by the State Engineer of the State of Oregon for the appropriation of 0.05 cubic second-feet of the waters of Tunnel in accordance with the tenor of such permit and the limitations endorsed thereon by the State Engineer, began the actual construction of the works described therein on the 28th day of August, 1929 being within the time limitation as fixed in said permit for the beginning of construction work.
