



2. Water right certificate number 15945, issued to H.W. 3. I have abandoned any and all interest in the right appurtenant to my property and request the certificate be cancelled.

- 6. That I believe that the presumption of forfeiture for five of more years of nonuse cannot and will not be rebutted by the holder(s) of the water right, because the holder(s) of the water right cannot show that any of the following items as listed in ORS 540.610(2) apply:
- a) That the water right in question is for use of water, or rights of use, acquired by a city or town for municipal purposes;
- b) That a finding of forfeiture would impair the rights of such a city or town to the use of water, however acquired, previously or in the future;
- c) That the use of water or rights of use are appurtenant to property obtained by the Department of Veterans' Affairs for a period of 3 years after the expiration of redemptions while the land is held by the Department of Veterans' Affairs, during which 3 year period any nonuse is not included as part of the period of more than five successive years of nonuse;
- d) That the owner of the property in question was unable to use the water because of economic hardship due to bankruptcy, foreclosure, redemption by the Department of Veterans' Affairs, for a period of 3 years following the expiration of redemptions or 3 years from recording of a deed in lieu of foreclosure, or limitation or prohibition of normal use of water as a result of judicial actions or natural disaster, as described in OAR 690-17-800;
- e) That the alleged period of nonuse occured during a period of time during which the land was withdrawn from use under the Federal Conservation Reserve Program or other federal reserve program described in ORS 540.610(2);
- f) That the end of the alleged period of nonuse occurred more than 15 years before the date of this affidavit;
- g) That an order of the Water Resources Commission has discontinued the use of water under the certificate;

and that I am willing to testify to all allegations contained in this affidavit in a contested case hearing before the Water Resources Department if necessary.
