Remarks: Waste water flows off of irrigated field south of County road and empties into narrow ditch which runs parallel to and follows the County road as indicated on enclosed map.

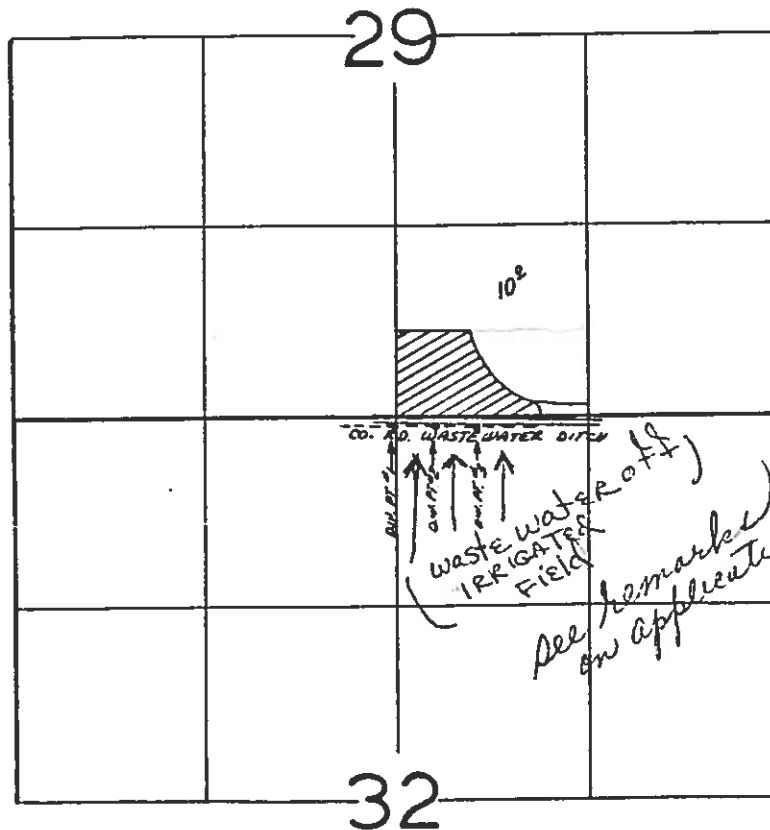
