PROPOSED CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GENEVIEVE M. ELLIOTT  
HC 84, BOX 12010  
BROADBENT, OREGON 97414

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN SUPPLY TO BE APPROPRIATED FROM THE SOUTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER, A tributary of THE COQUILLE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 0.8 ACRE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 40885. The date of priority is JULY 16, 1976. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

LOT 11 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4), LOT 11 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4) SECTION 22, T 30 S, R 12 W, W.M.; UNNAMED STREAM - 2450 FEET NORTH AND 2950 FEET EAST, RIVER - 2200 FEET NORTH AND 2450 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 22.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

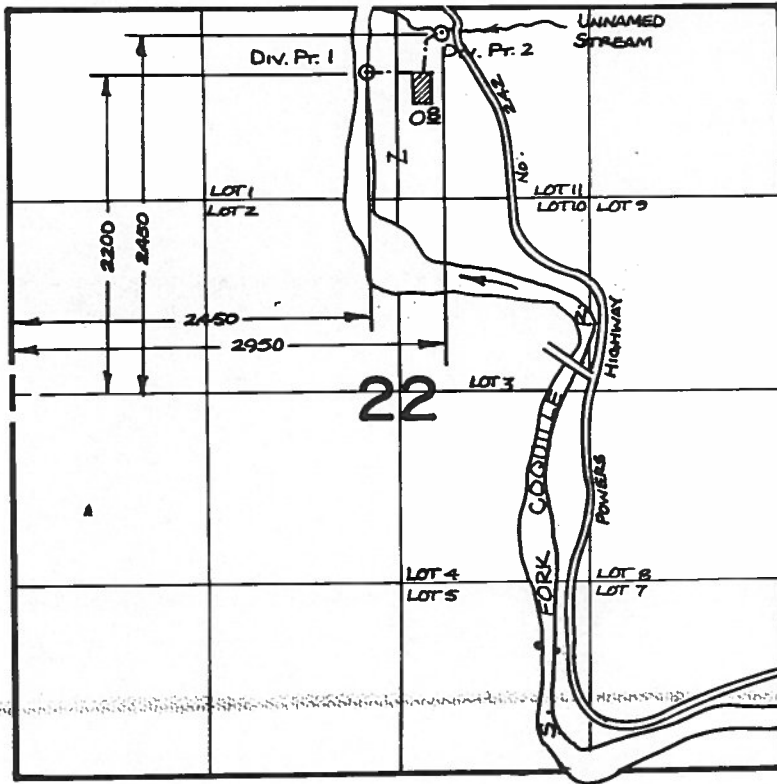
The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.

This will acknowledge your map, legal description, fees of \$25.00, and an application for a permit to appropriate 0.015 cubic foot per second of water from an unnamed stream for the irrigation of 0.61 acres with any deficiency to be made up by an appropriation from South Fork Coquille River, and 0.17 cubic foot per second of water from South Fork Coquille River for the irrigation of 5.05 acres. Your application has been filed as No. 54516.

Permits will be issued for use of water from Coquille River and its tributaries with the understanding that water may not be available during the dry periods of the irrigation season. The available water may be needed to satisfy existing rights or meet the minimum flow standards established.

As filed, your application requires the \$20.00 examination fee and a \$10.00 permit recording fee for irrigation. Therefore, an additional \$5.00 is required.

Upon receipt of the additional \$5.00 recording fee, your application will be in satisfactory form.

Supplement to application

4. Diversion point # 4. is located on a small unnamed creek that rises or originates on our place. It flows only in the rainy season and for a short time thereafter. In May or June, according to the rainfall after the first of the year, it ceases to flow all the way to the river. There is enough water flowing to diversion point four however, to irrigate a small garden and get the plants started, before it goes completely dry.

6c. A  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rotary pump will handle all the water available at the time it is needed to start the garden.

11, 12, 13.

A single,  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " centrifugal pump with gas engine attached, and readily portable, is planned for diversion from the river for two reasons.....

- a. Less pipeline will be required.
- b. A rise and fall of approximately 20 feet in the water level of the river in the winter, makes maintenance of a permanent installation impractical and expensive.
