under Permit No. 30056 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 21, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.225 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEW SWK, Section 35, T. 11 S., R. 43 E., W. M. Diversion point located: 3440 feet South and 4500 feet East from NV Corner, Section 34.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.





This will acknowledge receipt of your returned application No. 43207 and the map.

If you intend to irrigate from October 1 to March 31 of each year on lands that now have existing rights for irrigation during the summer months, than the map and the number of acres to be irrigated in each forty must agree with the location of these lands, as shown in the earlier rights.

The map, which you submitted, does not now agree to the location of the lands irrigated with the older rights. The application map is made a permanent part of the record, and should therefore, be a more durable quality of tracing paper, if at all possible. The area to be irrigated should be more clearly defined by cross-hatching as shown on Page 8 of the enclosed booklet of Rules and Regulations.

I am returning your application and the map for correction and completion. The application is endorsed so that in order to retain its date of priority, it must be returned on or before May 3, 1967.
