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Water is gravity fed from Lake Tony to a smaller storage pond ("Lower Pond") from which water is pumped and distributed to the irrigated areas via a pumping station and underground piping.

Water stored at Lake Tony is gravity fed to Lower Pond via a buried pipeline that is valved on the Lake Tony end. From Lower Pond, water feeds into a pump gallery which pumps water via underground PVC piping to the irrigated portions of the golf course and support facilities.

Please describe why the amount of water requested is needed and measures you propose to: prevent waste; measure the amount of water diverted; prevent damage to public uses of affected surface waters.

The amount of water requested is in line with existing groundwater right permit (No. G-15437) issued for this property and for the adjoining properties making up the Bandon Dunes Golf Resort. The amount of water used will be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, and 2.5 acre-feet per irrigated acre during the irrigation season. Groundwater will be appropriated from up to 5 wells and diverted to Lake Tony for temporary storage. Lake Tony is a storage pond created by lining an excavated borrow bit. The liner will minimize water losses due to infiltration. Water from Lake Tony feeds into Lower Pond and from there to a pump gallery that pumps the water via underground PVC piping to sprinklers located in the irrigated areas. The use of underground systems and irrigating primarily during the cooler nighttime hours helps to prevent evaporative losses. The application of water will be monitored carefully and adjusted to ensure water does not pond or runoff of the designated irrigation areas.

The water appropriated from each well is monitored with an in-line flowmeter mounted at the wellhead. Water level in Lake Tony and Lower Pond will be maintained at a constant level to protect the liners and for wildlife protection.

	Lake Tony is an artificial pond not connected to any other surface water body. No fish or wildlife will be maintained in the pond and therefore no diversion screens will be required. The pond will be kept topped up to prevent wildlife from slipping on the liner material and becoming trapped.




