Dear Mr. Wheeler,

In answer to your letter of Nov. 1, we would like to submit the following information about our application for a water right which you filed under no. G-2726.

The legal description from our abstract is: North-west $\frac{1}{4}$ of South-east $\frac{1}{4}$ and the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of the South-east $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2 Township 39 South Range 5 West of The Willamette Meridian, Josephine County, Oregon, containing 120 acres more or less.

Concerning the waste water, the sump is in the lowest place in a half circle of swale, covered and irrigated by Permit numbers 2600 and 2729. This swale is too wet to farm right until the middle of the summer as it is now. We want to drain it by tile so the waste water drains to the sump by both tile and surface water. We are not able to keep some irrigation water from wasting into the swale when irrigating these 8 acres.

We are enclosing another map to better explain the ground.

Dear Sir and Madam:

This will acknowledge your application for a permit to appropriate 99 gallons of water per minute from a sump for the irrigation of 18 acres, the accompanying tracing, and fees in the sum of \$15 for which our receipt numbered 40126 is enclosed.

Your application has been examined and filed under file number G-2726. Before your application is considered for approval by issuance of a permit, it is requested that you submit a legal description of the property upon which the water is to be used. This should be copied word for word from your deed, abstract, title insurance, or sales contract.

It is noted that in describing the source of appropriation, you indicated that a drain tile carries ground water from a swampy section of land to the sump. You also mention that waste irrigation water drains into the sump; but, from the description, it is not clear whether this surface drainage drains directly into the sump or whether it drains into the swampy area and is conveyed to the sump through your drain tile. Please give an explanation when you submit the legal description. We will withhold further action on your application pending your reply.
