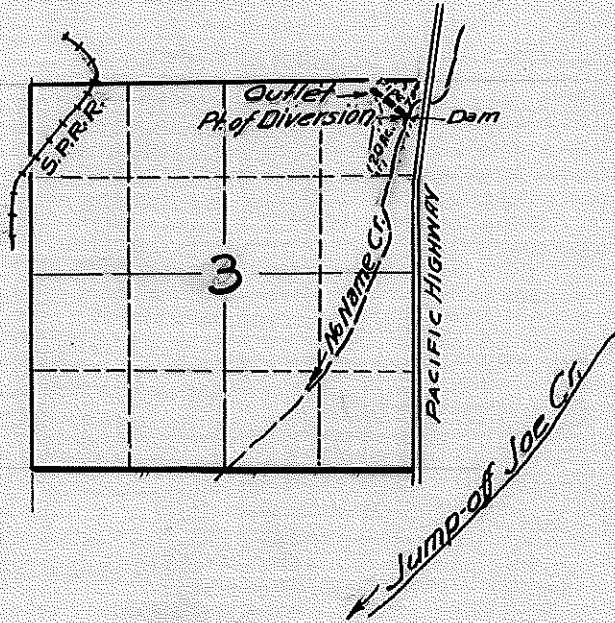

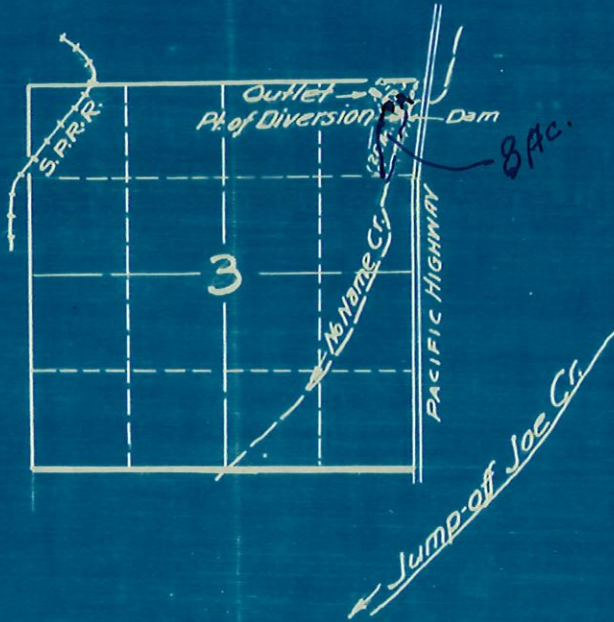

Dear Sir:

Your problem of constructing a reservoir for storage of water to be used under Permit No. 7163 is one on which I am not able to give you information that will probably be of material assistance. One point which should be called to your attention is that this permit does not grant a right to store water, but is for a direct diversion from this Unnamed Stream for irrigation of 20 acres. If you plan to construct a reservoir for seasonal storage of water, it is probable that you should have a reservoir permit. We will furnish you a blank for making a reservoir application if you request it.

It very likely will not be practical for you to employ any method of water proofing to prevent the leakage of water from your reservoir. If the soil is of such character that this water seeps away, it could only be stopped by a concrete lining or some lining equally water proof. I have heard of asphalt being used to prevent seepage in a ditch, but have had no actual experience with this method. Your letter indicates that you are having difficulty in securing water from this stream as it is all appropriated at some point above you. In that case it would seem advisable for you to develop your supply of water if an adequate supply may be secured in that way.

In order to allow you to determine what area can be irrigated under Permit No. 7163 and to make actual application of this water if a supply is available, I am extending the time for complete application of water until October 1, 1931. If you find before that date that you will not be able to irrigate from this stream, my advice is that you authorize the cancellation of the permit.

In reply to your inquiry card about permit No 7163, I am at least what to do.

It is a strange proposition and each year the last week in June all the water escapes.

I put the dam 6 feet down in bed rock yet for as far as 10 feet in front of gate the bubbles would arise indication of a leak. I shoveled dirt in and would stop one place, yet in 3 days all was gone.

What can you suggest
to do?

No water runs in the creek
in summer as some people
 $\frac{1}{4}$ mile up creek have a
pump near the creek yet
their allowed 10 feet from
creek. They pump and
irrigate all spring and
summer.

The granite soil may be
too porous to form a bank
as the corn grew real rank
until hot weather and
water was gone.

I planted corn and a
large garden to use
the water, yet no water
when needed.

I cannot go to the expense to build cement tanks large enough to contain enough water. I already have 3 wells, that do not run dry and wonder if a few more would be better than try to contain any. Please tell me if you had an experience with this granite soil in dam building?

I want water in fact nothing can be done with the place without it. But how?

I was away from home when you said case came. Pardon the delay.

ABSTRACT OF CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT NO. 9702

H. E. and DELIA WALKER

of Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Engineer of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, tributary of Jump Off Joe Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of Irrigation

under Permit No. 7163 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

February 4, 1926;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.1 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 3, Township 35 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant (if for irrigation or any other purpose) is as follows: 8 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 3, Township 35 South, Range 6 West, Willamette Meridian, in Josephine County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for any purpose is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
