The goal of this application is to cover tillable acreage between Certificates 12352 and 26648 with irrigation. Since water is not available from the Calapooia River after July 31, it is proposed to irrigate the remainder of the season as need from the water stored in Stellmacher Reservoir (proposed by a concurrently submitted alternate reservoir application). The beginning of the irrigation season when water is available from the river, it is requested to cover these same acres with supplemental from the reservoir in case of an earlier Watermaster regulation. Due to the entire irrigation system sharing a mainline and being tied together, it is also requested that the places of use in production under Certificates 12352 and 26648 be covered with supplemental irrigation from the reservoir for the entire season in case of a severe Watermaster regulation on the Calapooia.

The goal is not to achieve more water other than that on the uncovered areas. The goal of this project is to conserve water and design a more efficient irrigation system for the entire farm. The 0.74 cfs is a standard irrigation rate for the new 59.5 acres. All out of reservoir uses combined will not exceed 60 acre-feet.
