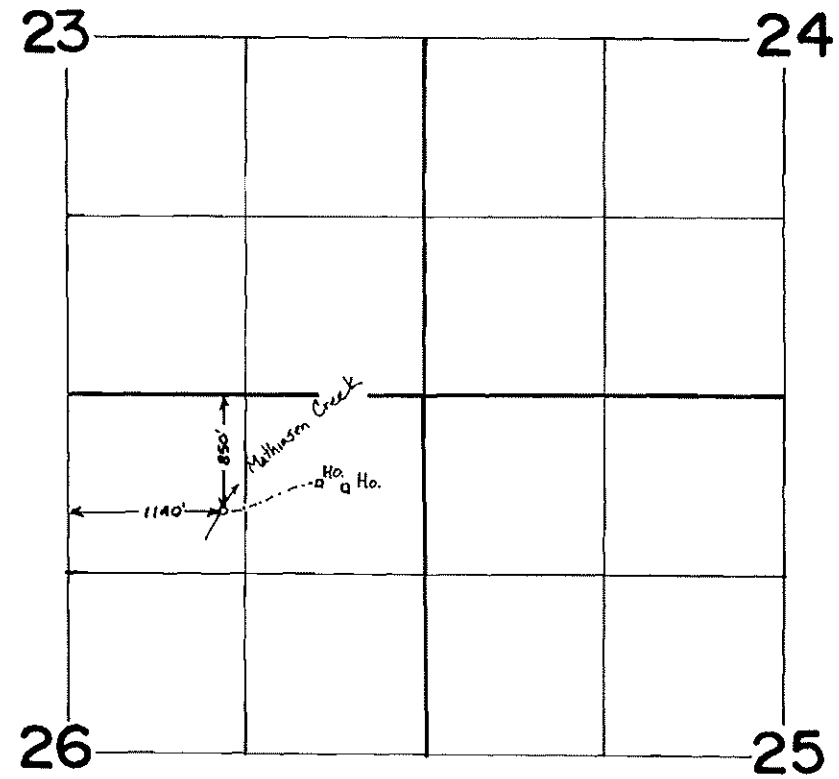

This is to certify, That REX L. MATHIASSEN

of 1907 South Side Road, Grants Pass, State of OR 97526, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Mathiasen Creek

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of domestic use for two families including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed one-half acre in area for each under Permit No. 45229 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 19, 1980 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 26, T37S, R6W, WM; 850 feet South and 1140 feet East from N 1/4 corner Section 26.

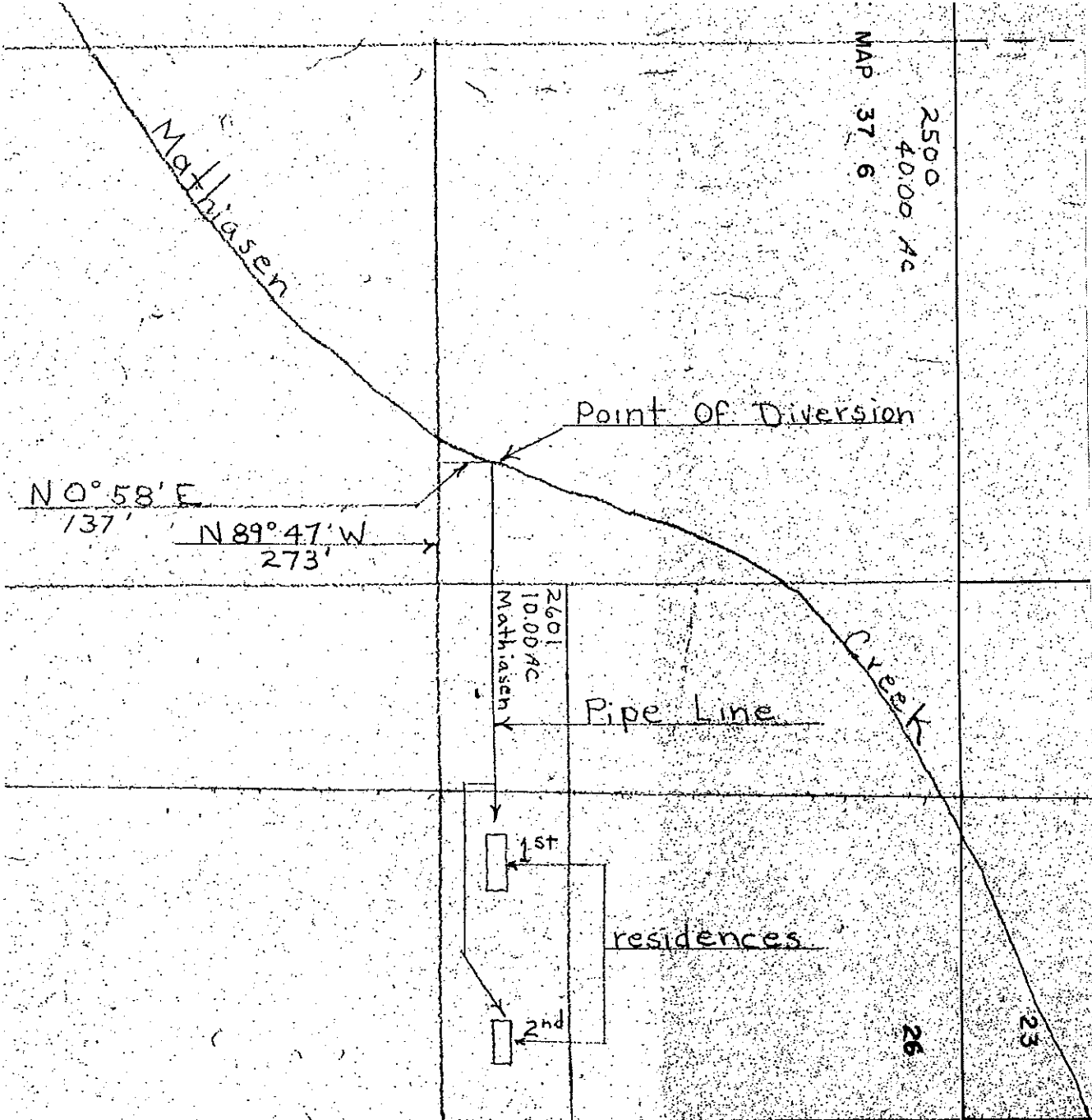

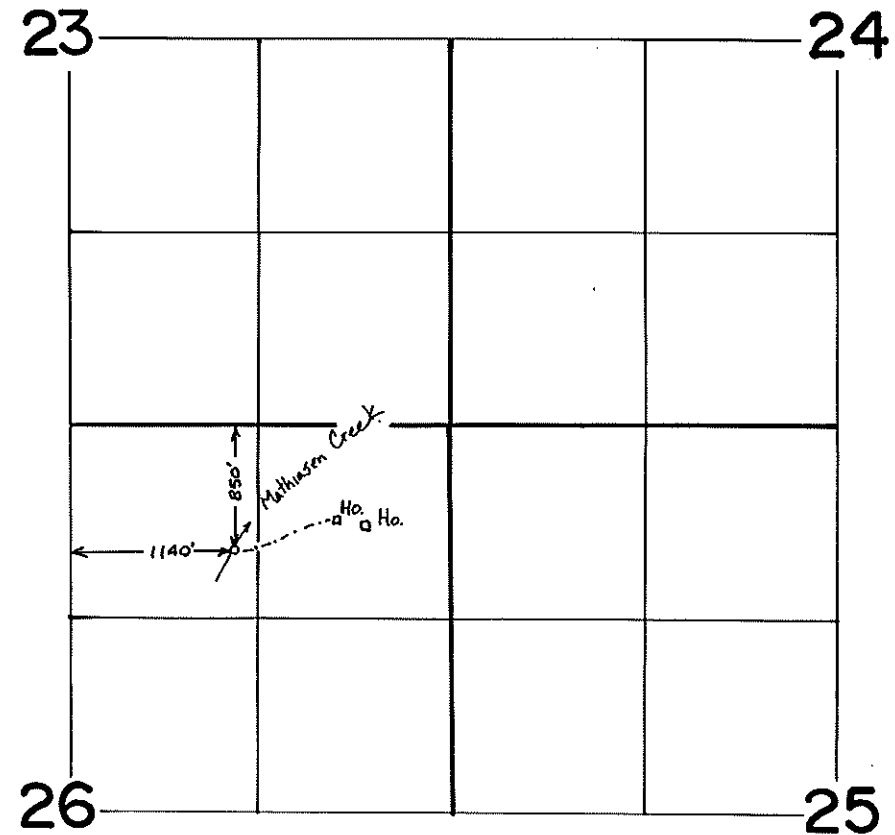

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Mathiasen Creek Trib. Applegate Riv

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use of two families including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre noncommercial lawn and garden for each

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 19, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 26, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983

Dear Mr. Mathiasen:

Thank you for submitting the new map to accompany your application number 60276.

Permits will be issued for use of water from the Applegate River and its tributaries. However, water may not be available during dry periods. The water may be needed to satisfy existing rights or minimum flow standards.

Issuance of a permit does not authorize construction of pipelines, ditches, or other works on property not owned or controlled by the water user. Any easement, right of way, or right of access necessary to the intended use of water is a private matter between the water user and the property owner involved.

Your application is now in satisfactory form and will be considered for the issuance of a permit with our next group.

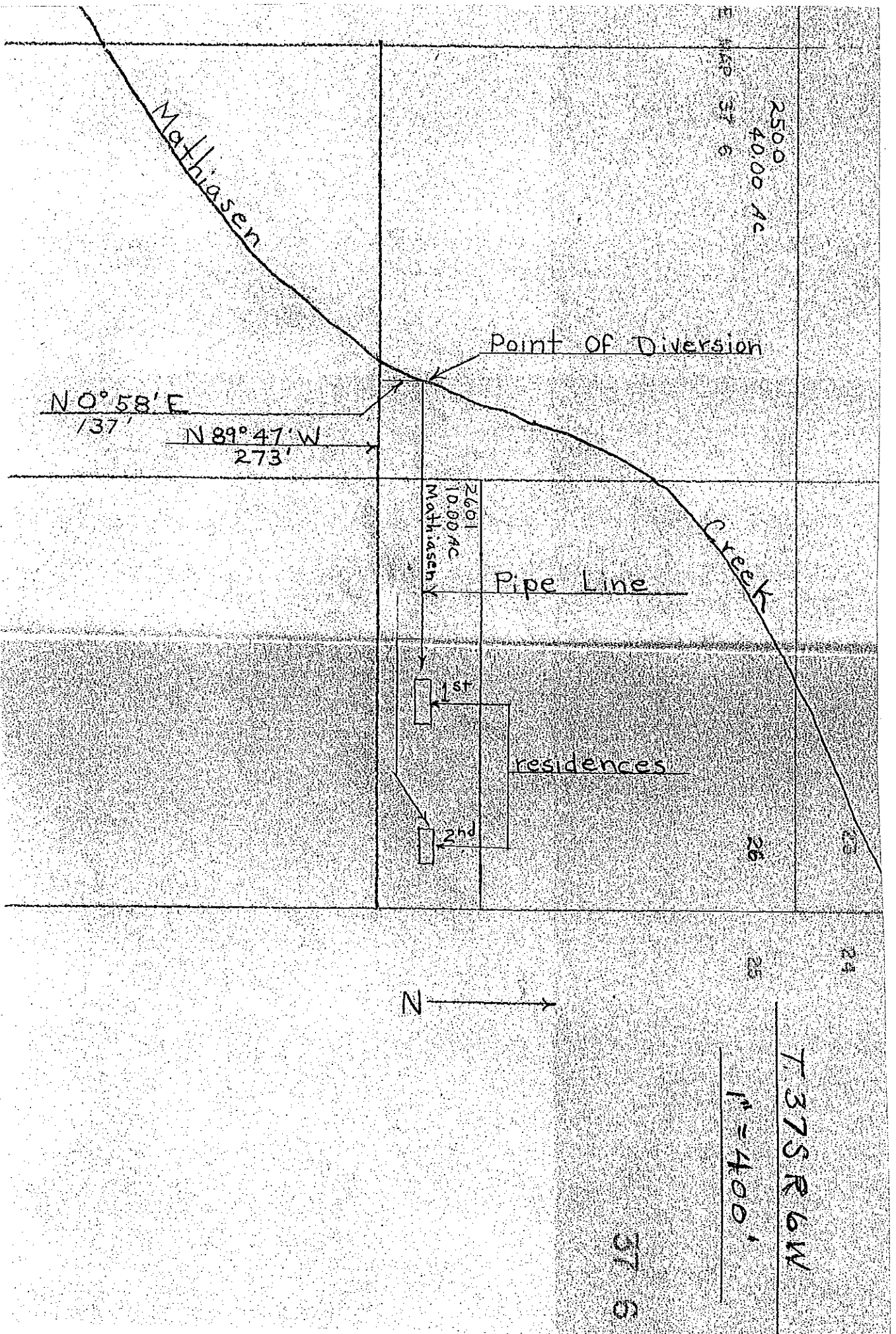

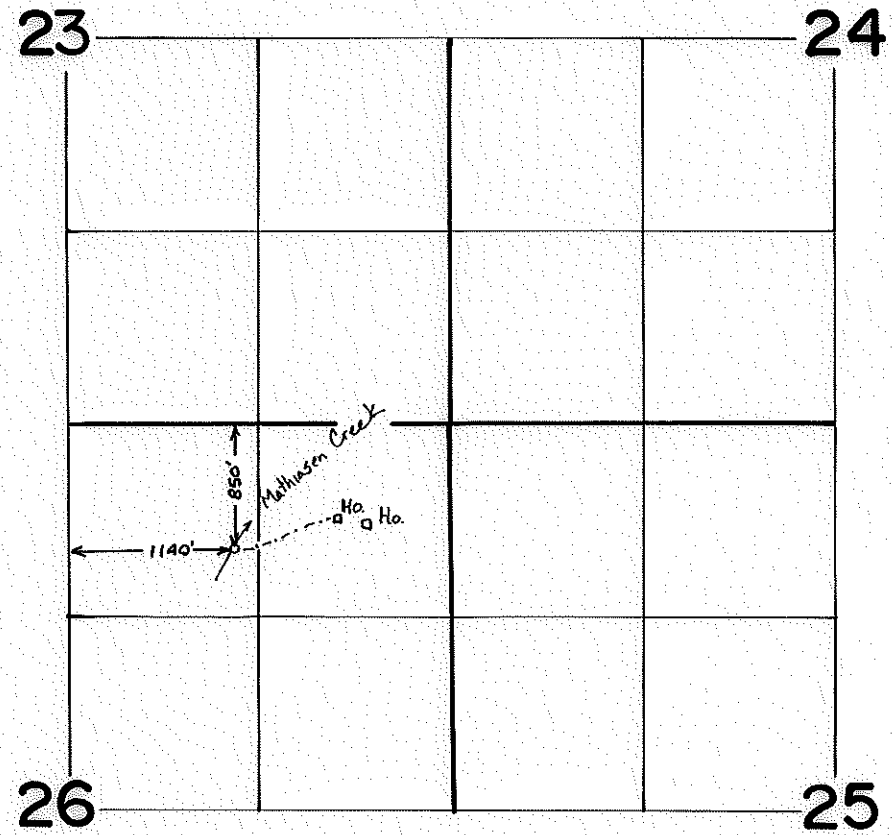
