

under Permit No. 10895 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 26, 1933;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.31 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, being 0.25 cubic foot per second from Elder Creek and 0.06 cubic foot per second from springs, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located in the $NW_{\frac{1}{4}}SE_{\frac{1}{4}}$, Section 23, and $NE_{\frac{1}{4}}NE_{\frac{1}{4}}$, Section 26, Township 40 South, Range 8 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to one-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, throughout the irrigation season from April 1st to November 1st of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
