Dear Mrs. Patton:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of October 15, 1949 relative to your Permit No. 16966, in which you state that you cannot fill out the forms notifying us of completion of construction and complete application of water for the reason that you have been unable to complete the work and bring the land under cultivation.

Under date of October 12, 1948, you wrote advising that construction work had not been completed and in response thereto under date of October 18, 1949, we mailed a blank form for your use in filing an application for an extension of time for the reason that under the terms of your permit, construction was to be completed on October 1, 1948, and the water completely applied to beneficial use on October 1, 1949. To date, we have not received an application for an extension of time in which to complete construction work and in order that your permit may remain valid, it will now be necessary for you to submit to this office at your earliest convenience, an application for an extension of time in which to complete construction and apply the water to beneficial use as specified under the terms of your permit.

For your convenience in submitting such an application, I am enclosing herewith a blank form for that purpose which when properly executed, notarized and returned to this office with the statutory \$2.00 fee, the matter of extending the time limits under your permit will be given further attention.



Dear Sir:

Your notice of Oct. 1st did not receive prompt reply because I was hoping to have funds by Oct. 10th so that I could continue more work in bringing my farm land into production this fall.

I now find it will not be possible to do this before next spring and trust you can see your way clear to grant an extension.

There is a well ditched and gravelled $3/4$ mile road in from the highway to the river and we have fields cleared for alfalfa, etc., but have been unable to get fence and pipe lines installed. However, have adequate fencing and pipe for about an acre and a half, which I am cultivating intensely as garden and orchard, using an electric motor and getting water from the river

If this is not sufficient to permit of your granting an extension, please advise how I can later get a reinstatement.
