

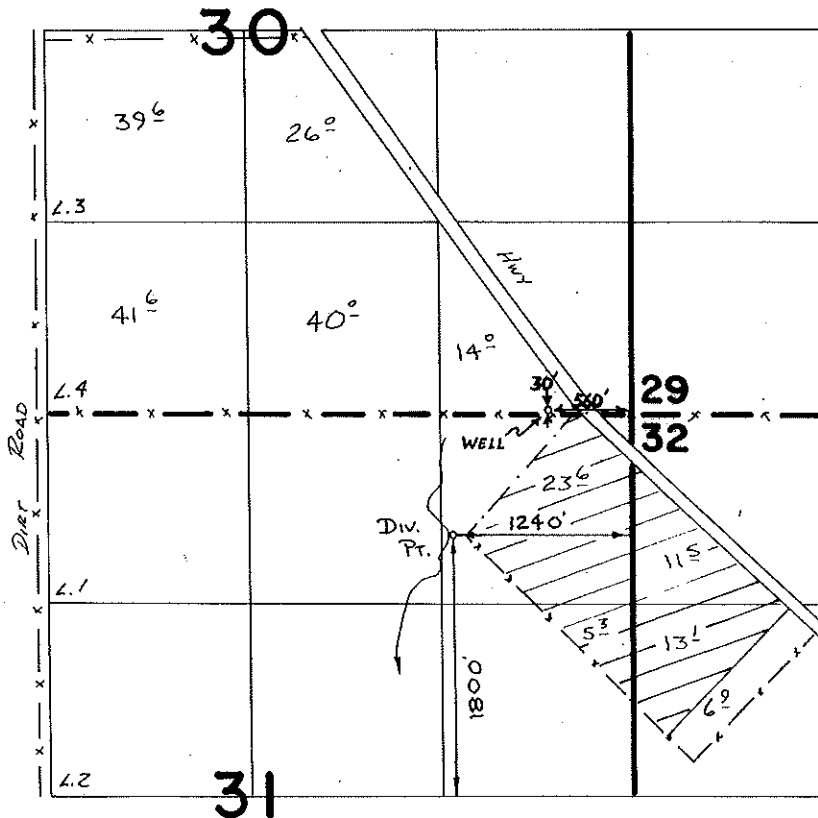



NOTICE OF CERTIFICATE ISSUANCE

The attached certificate confirms the water right established under the terms of a permit issued by this department. The water right is now appurtenant to the specific place where the use was established as described by the certificate. The water right is limited to a specific amount of water, but not more than can be beneficially used for the purposes stated within the certificate.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within **60 days of the mailing date stated above** as specified by ORS 183.484(2).

This statement of judicial review rights is required under ORS 536.075; it does not alter or add to existing review rights or create review rights that are not otherwise provided by law.

Under ORS 537.260 and 537.270, a water right certificate may be contested before the Water Resources Department within three (3) months of the date it is issued. If a certificate is contested, the qualifying contestant shall be offered an administrative hearing.

Oregon law does not allow the Director to reissue a certificate because of a change in the ownership of the appurtenant place of use. The water must be controlled and not wasted. To change the location of the point of diversion, the character of use, or the location of use requires the advance approval of the Water Resources Director.

If any portion of this water right is not used for five or more consecutive years, that portion of the right may be subject to forfeiture according to ORS 540.610. Land enrolled in a Federal Reserve Program is not subject to forfeiture during the period of enrollment. Other exceptions to forfeiture are explained in ORS 540.610.

Dear Mr. Overcash:

I hope this is the final attempt to supply what you require for these permits. In each case I have furnished what you asked.

The surface water is not required to make up a deficiency from the primary source - the well. The point is that the water from Lake Malheur is available now - but not normally - due to the abnormally high water levels we have experienced the past four years. Heaven knows the lake needs to be reduced by some means! I can pump from the slough which is now an arm of the lake at considerably less cost than from the well. When and if the lake recedes the surface water will not be available and all the water will be supplied by the well.

I hope this explains the situation and that I can count on an early immediate approval of these permits.

Application G-11378 originally requested to use a well and an unnamed slough. The applicant requested a permit to use the well as the primary right, but to use the slough, instead of the well, when water was high in Malheur Lake. During flood periods, the lake overflowed into the slough. The applicant said it was then cheaper to pump from the slough. During processing the Department required the applicant to submit a surface water application for use of the slough.

The ground water permit was issued as primary; the surface water as supplemental. The two permits were issued with language that said, in effect, in the interest of conserving ground water, the slough could be used at times when ground water was available.

Vern Church did the final proof survey in May 1988. He found that the slough as being used, but not the well. The well was being used on other lands for which there was also a permit.

This is one of those strange situations where the primary and supplemental relationship is reversed. The supplemental right, acting as the primary, is used. The primary right, in its supplemental role, is not. Now, should the primary right be lost because of non-use?

I recommend that both rights be perfected, as we would with other more conventional primary and supplemental rights. The supplemental surface water because it has been used. The primary ground water because the water user was ready, willing, and able, but just didn't need the additional water yet.
