The requested assignment from Northwest Farm Credit Services, FLCA to V Dash Cattle Co. cannot be made as this is a perfected right as evidenced by the issuance of a Certificate of Water Right. Under Oregon Water Law, a perfected right is considered a land right and goes with the land. Therefore, if you own land that has a certified right you own the right as well. There is no provision in Oregon Water Law for changing the name on a certified right.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. 

NOTICE OF CERTIFICATE ISSUANCE

The attached certificate confirms the water right established under the terms of a permit issued by this department. The water right is now appurtenant to the specific place where the use was established as described by the certificate. The water right is limited to a specific amount of water, but not more than can be beneficially used for the purposes stated within the certificate.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within **60 days of the mailing date stated above** as specified by ORS 183.484(2).

This statement of judicial review rights is required under ORS 536.075; it does not alter or add to existing review rights or create review rights that are not otherwise provided by law.

Under ORS 537.260 and 537.270, a water right certificate may be contested before the Water Resources Department within three (3) months of the date it is issued. If a certificate is contested, the qualifying contestant shall be offered an administrative hearing.

Oregon law does not allow the Director to reissue a certificate because of a change in the ownership of the appurtenant place of use. The water must be controlled and not wasted. To change the location of the point of diversion, the character of use, or the location of use requires the advance approval of the Water Resources Director.

If any portion of this water right is not used for five or more consecutive years, that portion of the right may be subject to forfeiture according to ORS 540.610. Land enrolled in a Federal Reserve Program is not subject to forfeiture during the period of enrollment. Other exceptions to forfeiture are explained in ORS 540.610.

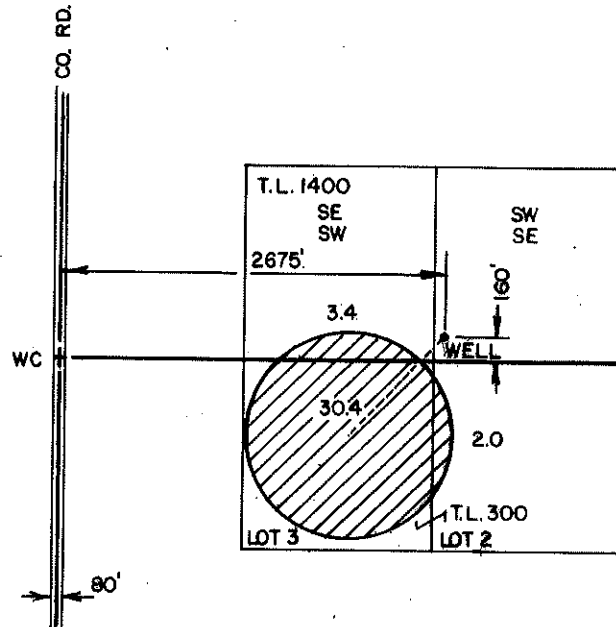

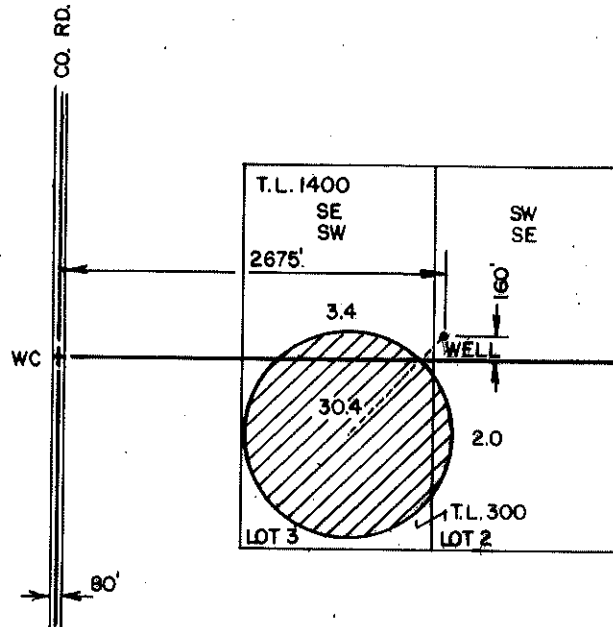

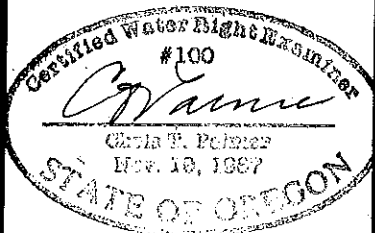

Dear Applicant:

The Water Resources Department has finished the first stage of its analysis of your application for a water right. Enclosed is a copy of this first report, which is called the Report of Technical Review.

The technical review is the Department's legal and scientific analysis of the application, including a calculation of the expected availability of water for your proposed use, an analysis of whether the use would conflict with other existing water rights, and if the use is compatible with the Department's river basin programs and local land use plans. Stage two, the Public Interest Review, is the next step.

In the case of your application, the Technical Review was satisfactory, and it concluded that water would be reliably available for this use for the time period described in the attached report. The report also includes other conditions which may be placed in the water right permit to protect other water users, the public or fish and wildlife habitat.

The Report of Technical Review report is only the first stage of the review process and does not authorize construction of a water system or the use of public waters. Nor does the report represent any commitment by the Department ultimately to approve your application. Before your water right may be granted, the Department must complete a public interest review.

In this second stage of the review process, state regulations require that other water users and the general public be given an opportunity to object to your proposed water use. You also may object to any of the Department's findings or proposed permit conditions contained in the technical report. If you wish to object, you must file your objection with the Department in writing by 5 p.m. on or before JANUARY 3, 1995. Interested parties must also submit their objections before the same deadline.



This is an application for use of groundwater. The Groundwater Section report indicates that:

Pursuant to OAR 690-09-040, the proposed groundwater withdrawal will not have the potential to cause substantial interference with surface water.

In addition, the Groundwater Section has reported the proposed water use, will if properly conditioned, avoid injury to existing rights or to the groundwater resource.

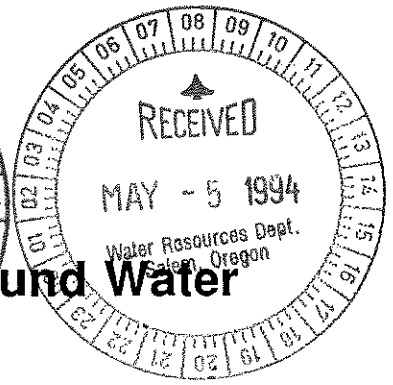
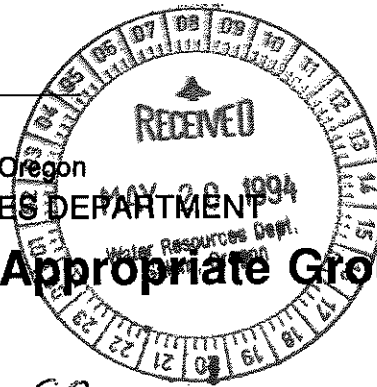

The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

6. Failure to comply with any of the provisions of the permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, penalties, or cancellation of the permit.
7. The permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.
8. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
9. The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.
10. Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.
11. The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE- EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
12. If substantial interference with a senior water right occurs due to withdrawal of water from any well listed on this permit, then use of water from the well(s) shall be discontinued or reduced and/or the schedule of withdrawal shall be regulated until or unless the Department approves or implements an alternative administrative action to mitigate the interference. The Department encourages junior and senior appropriators to jointly develop plans to mitigate interferences.

This application proposes to use 0.51 cfs of groundwater for irrigation from a well which is 52 feet deep. No water well report was located for the subject well, however, other shallow wells in the area produce water from an unconfined aquifer developed in sand and gravel. The subject well is no doubt also producing from the unconfined aquifer. Crowcamp Creek and other unnamed intermittent streams disappear or reappear in the valley west of the Stinkingwater Mountains. None of these streams are within 3200 feet of the subject well. The unconfined aquifer is locally in hydraulic connection with these streams, however, the distance to them is great enough to result in low potential for substantial interference.

The proposed water use described in Application #G-13694 has been evaluated according to the public interest standards set out in ORS 537.170 and OAR 690-11-195.

The Report of Technical Review for Application #G-13694 proposes allocation of 0.51 CFS from A WELL within the MALHEUR LAKE Basin for the purpose(s) of IRRIGATION OF 40.8 ACRES. The Technical Review Report limits the proposed use to BETWEEN MARCH 1 AND OCTOBER 31.

The proposed use described in Application #G-13694 is not within a category required to be submitted to the Commission.

The Director of the Water Resources Department has evaluated the Application for the proposed water use and made the following public interest determination.

TECHNICAL REVIEW

Water use Application #G-13694 received a Satisfactory Report of Technical Review.

The Technical Review revealed that the proposed water use:

- a) -is not prohibited by statute or scenic waterway criteria;
- b) -is a classified use under the applicable basin program or an application for the use has been filed under ORS 536.295 and OAR 690 Division 82;
- c) -is consistent with conditions previously imposed by the Commission on appropriations from the same source;
- d) -will not conflict with (an) existing water right(s);
- e) -is supported by an available source of water.

**PUBLIC INTEREST REVIEW
CHECKLIST**

The Director of the Water Resources Department has evaluated the proposed water use, as described in Application #G-13694, in light of current and planned uses and reasonably anticipated future demands for water from the water source as established in the record.

✓ If local government approval has not been granted, there is nothing in the record to indicate conditions cannot be placed on the proposed water use to require local land use approval prior to initiation of the use.

✓ An applicant for municipal water use has submitted information showing the proposed water use is compatible with comprehensive plan policies concerning urban services, urban growth boundaries, and Public Facilities Plans.

III. Identified environmental concerns.

- ✓ The proposed water use does not appropriate water from any water body listed to receive Total Maximum Daily Loads and therefore, the water body has not been defined as water quality limited according to Section 303(d)(1) of the federal Clean Water Act according to the information supplied by the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality.

IV. The character and extent of other natural resources which are present in the water source basin.

- ✓ The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) has been notified of the proposed water use and has made no objections regarding fish and other aquatic and wildlife species and populations.

- ✓ There are no listed threatened or endangered species in the water source according to the information supplied by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

V. Riparian characteristics.

The Director of the Water Resources Department, pursuant to OAR 690-11-185(4), has considered the facts set forth in the Application and its supporting data, the Director's Report of Technical Review and any objections which met the requirements of OAR 690-11-170(1).

The Director has determined that the proposed water use described in Application # G-13694 :

WILL IMPAIR OR BE DETRIMENTAL TO THE PUBLIC INTEREST and therefore, the Director hereby proposes rejection of the application and shall schedule a contested case hearing.

WILL NOT IMPAIR OR BE DETRIMENTAL TO THE PUBLIC INTEREST and therefore, the Director shall issue a water use permit with appropriate conditions.

This application proposes to use 0.51 cfs of groundwater for irrigation from a well which is 52 feet deep. No water well report was located for the subject well, however, other shallow wells in the area produce water from an unconfined aquifer developed in sand and gravel. The subject well is no doubt also producing from the unconfined aquifer. Crowcamp Creek and other unnamed intermittent streams disappear or reappear in the valley west of the Stinkingwater Mountains. None of these streams are within 3200 feet of the subject well. The unconfined aquifer is locally in hydraulic connection with these streams, however, the distance to them is great enough to result in low potential for substantial interference.

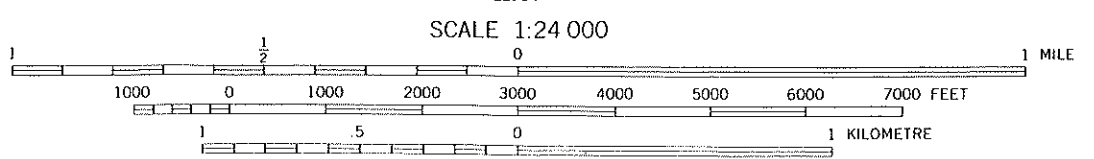
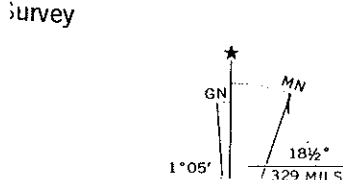
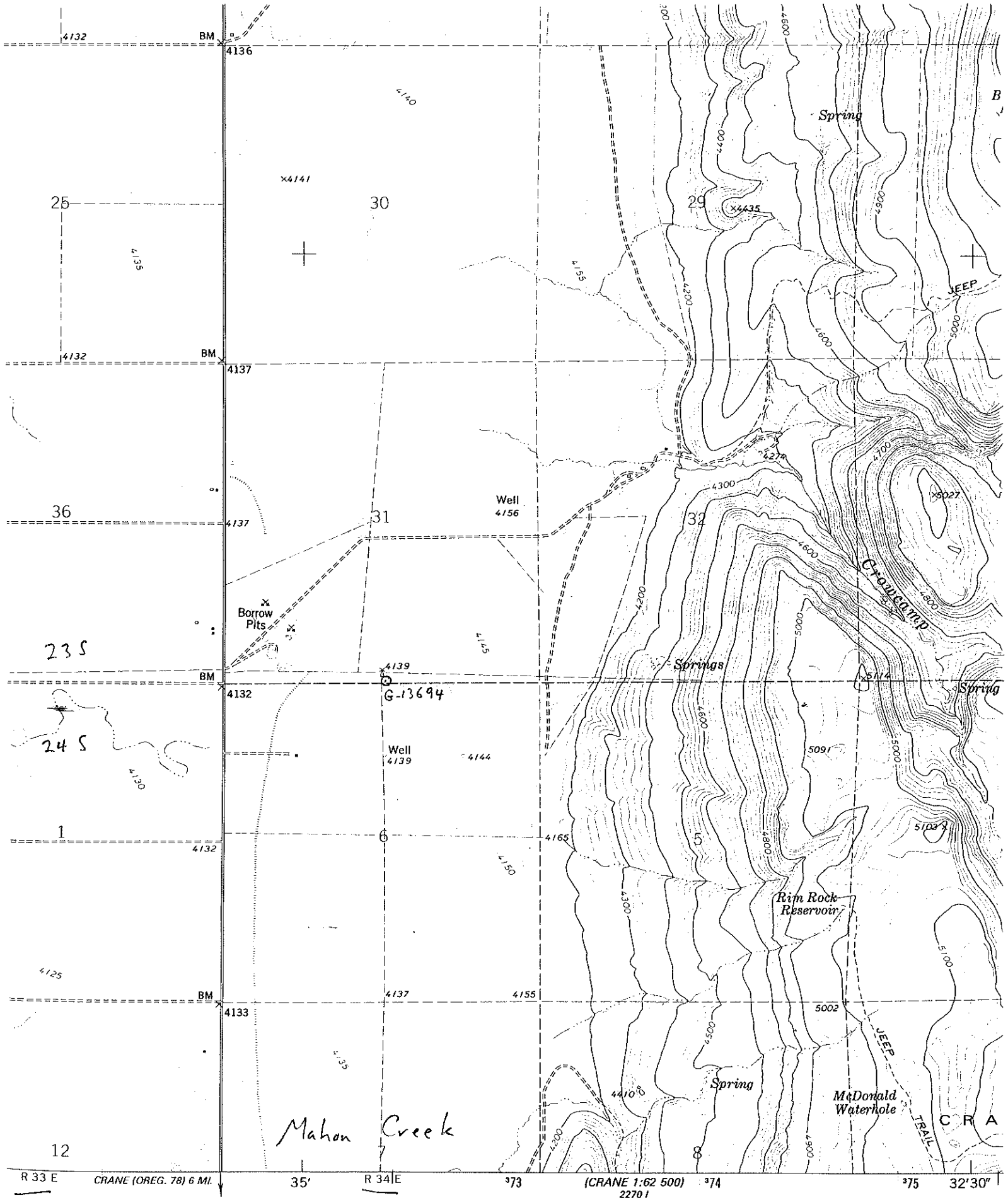

WaterWatch has reviewed the limited amount of information contained in the public notice of this water right application. Based upon that information, WaterWatch raises the following issues, questions and concerns:

Is there unappropriated water available for this proposed use? How will the Department determine water availability for this proposed use? What will be the cumulative effect of this proposed use, in combination with other, already existing uses of the aquifer?

Is the groundwater source in question in hydraulic connection with surrounding surface waters? If so, what is the amount of surface water depletion and what effect will this proposed use have on instream flows necessary to protect the public's interest in fish, wildlife, recreation and a health aquatic system? We oppose any application which in any way reduces surface water flows needed for the public uses that are served by any instream water right.

Given the importance of this groundwater resource, and the Department's limited enforcement staff, it only makes sense to require this applicant to measure and record water use. Measurement not only helps the Department carry out its statutory mandate to promote the control of water resources in Oregon for all beneficial uses, it helps the Department protect the public's interest in assuring the use is within the bounds of the permit. ORS 536.220(1)(a), 537.170(5)

Will this proposed use be compatible with Goal 5 elements in the local comprehensive plan?

It is a high priority of the state to eliminate waste and improve the efficiency of water use. OAR 690-410-060(1) Statewide policy also calls upon water users to use and maintain their water systems in a manner consistent with the state's priority. What conditions are proposed for this permit that will carry out and encourage compliance with state policy?

Is this an existing illegal use of water? If so, will the continued use without a permit cause harm to existing water rights and the public interest?
