

Abstract of Permit

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **G-11173** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Harold Woodruff of Burns, Oregon 97720, phone 573-7781**, for use of the waters from one well,

for the PURPOSE of **irrigation of 39.1 acres** *421 K08*

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **March 13, 1984**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.49 cubic foot per second**

measured at the point of diversion from the **well**, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The well is to be LOCATED: **1090 feet South and 1120 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 8, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 8, Township 24 South, Range 30 East, WM, in the County of Harney.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **June 22, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 19 85**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 19 86**.

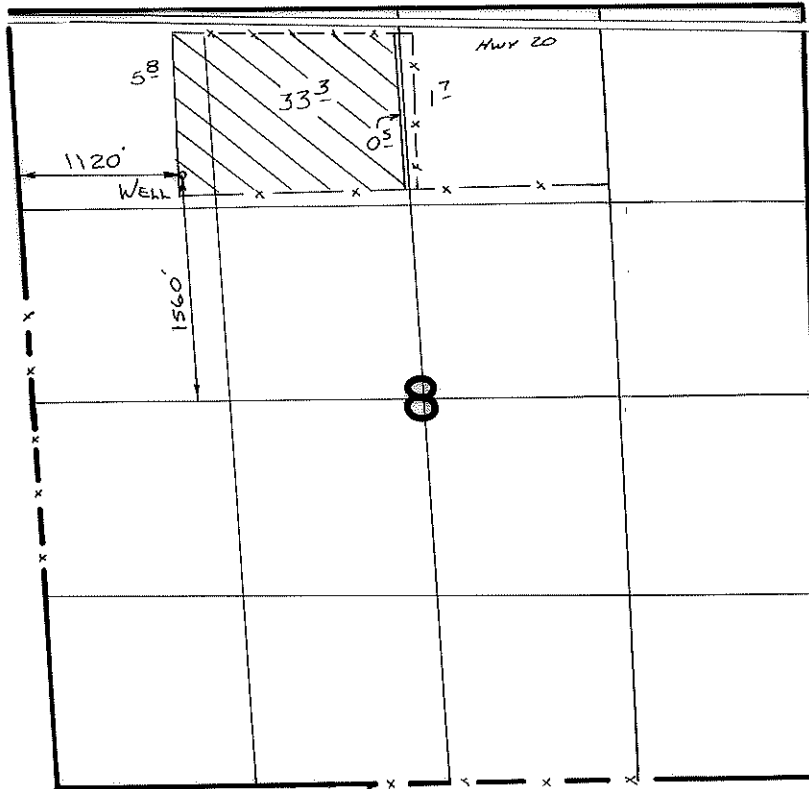

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the LITTLE SAGE HEN CREEK BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 39.1 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-10383. The date of priority is MARCH 13, 1984. The right is limited to not more than 0.49 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

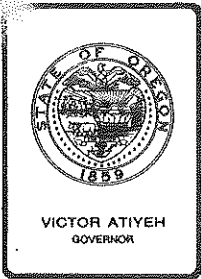

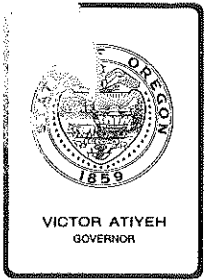

Your Application G-11173 describing the proposed use of 0.5 cubic foot per second of water from one well for the irrigation of 43.5 acres, together with the map, has been reviewed.

The forms A, B, and C you submitted did not refer to any application or permit numbers; therefore, are being returned. If they relate to your Application G-11173, instead of submitting the forms, you may merely state in the remark section what has been accomplished.

A portion of the acreage illustrated on your supporting maps, specifically in the southerly part, are presently covered by an existing water right, evidenced by the Certificate 39762, issued to Adolf J. Kisle and a Permit G-8912 issued to J.J. Praggastis. I am enclosing copies of the maps relative to the permit and water right. If you do not intend to overlap on these existing rights, it will be necessary for you to correct your supporting map. However, if your map correctly represents the acreage you intend to irrigate from your well, it will be necessary for you to provide for clearing our records of the existing rights involved.

So that you may review your application, I am returning it to you along with your supporting map for completion. The application is endorsed so that in order to retain its priority date it must be received in this office on or before February 19, 1984.

Applications which are received in proper form for a permit, including maps, supporting data and fees, will receive a permit shortly after the mandatory 30-day waiting period. Applications which are defective, conflict with existing rights or require additional information will be reviewed in detail and will be returned for completion or correction within 45 days.

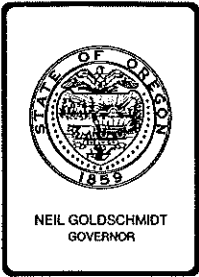

Enclosed is a proposed certificate of water right and a map which illustrates the location of the right. The map and proposed certificate represent the extent water was used within the terms of the permit based upon a survey and inspection made by a representative of this department.

If you do not agree with the proposed certificate or the map, Oregon Administrative Rule 690-11-110 allows the permittee or landowner 60 days from the mailing date of this notice to petition the Department to reconsider the contents of the proposed certificate.

If you agree with the proposed certificate and map no response to this notice is required. Shortly after the 60 day period, the recorded certificate of water right will be mailed to you.

Our field examiner found a total of 41.3 acres claimed irrigated in connection with Permit No. G10383 which exceeds the limit of 39.1 acres under the permit. If you intend to establish a legal water right for the additional 2.2 acres, a permit must be obtained. We will assist you in making an application for a permit for the additional land at your request.

The 2.2 acres overacreage is displayed on the map copy as an unhatched area. If this area is not located where you prefer it to be, please notify us as it may be possible to locate the area elsewhere on your lands.

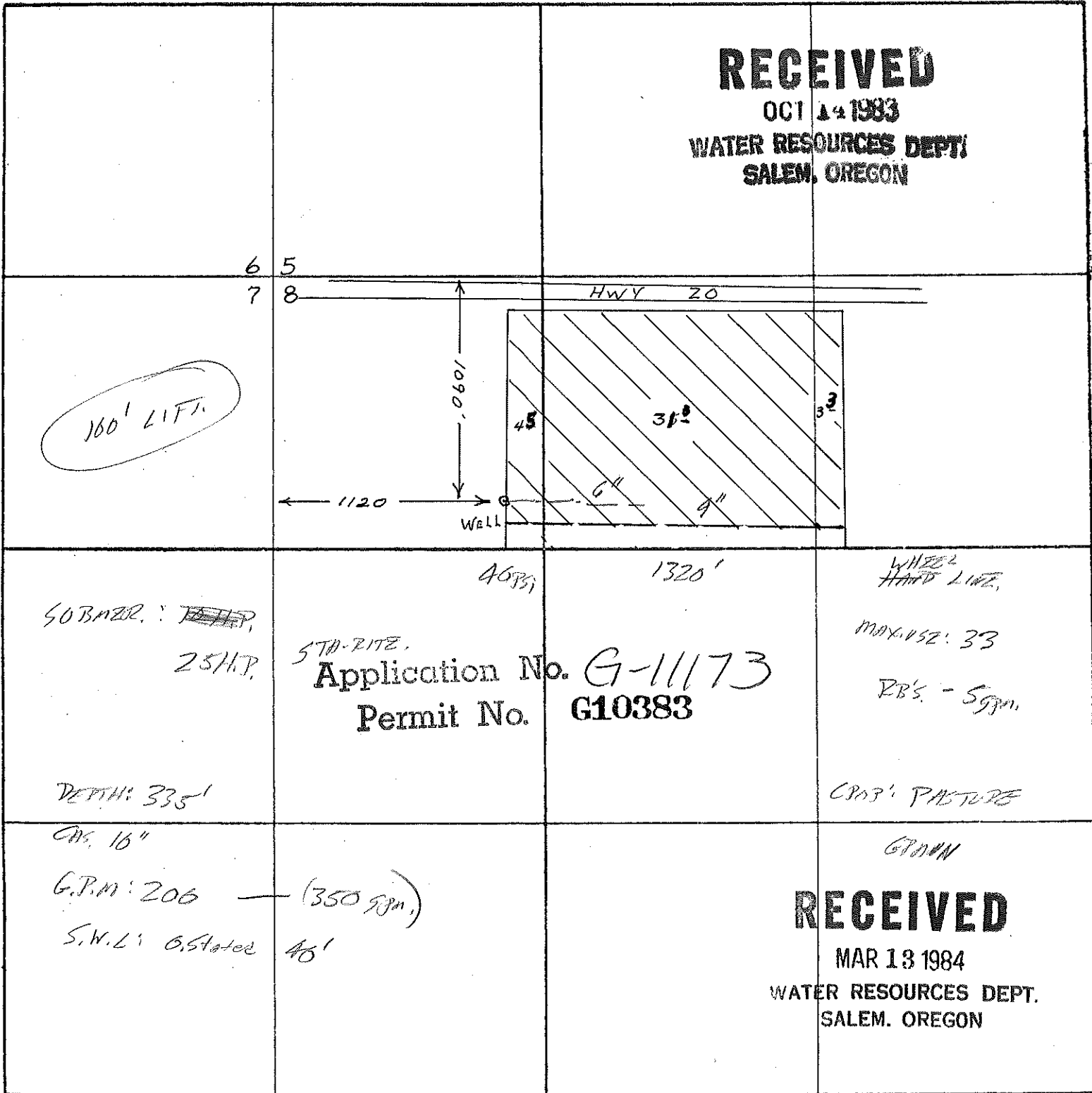
