HARRY PON

c/o Bradeen Brothers of P. O. Box 1113, Burns, State of Oregon, has applied beneficially the waters of a well

a tributary of East Branch Foley Slough (Silvies River) for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 57.0 acres

under Permit No. G-3904 of the State Engineer, and that the use of said waters has been completed under the terms of said permit; that the priority of the right dates from February 13, 1968

that the amount of water for the purposes aforesaid, has been actually beneficially used in the amount of 0.62 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 31, T. 22 S., R. 31 E., W. M. Well located: 2530 feet North and 60 feet West from E 1/4 Corner, Section 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
