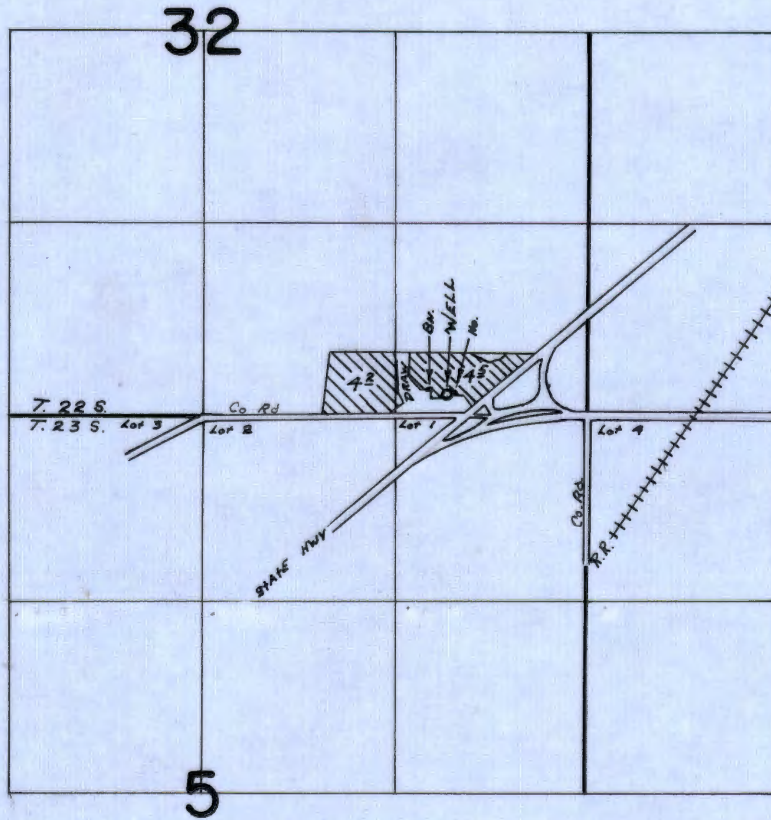

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 32, T. 22 S., R. 31 E., W. M., 140 feet North and 970 feet West from SE Corner, Section 32.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **3 acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.




Dear Mr. Tiller:

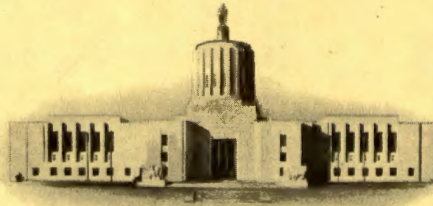

This will acknowledge receipt of your notice to the effect that complete application of water has been made under permit No. 04293.

This will acknowledge receipt of your application for a permit to appropriate 110 gallons of water per minute from a well for the supplemental irrigation of 12 acres, a map, and the fee of \$15 for which our receipt No. 11132 is enclosed.

Your application, which has been filed and numbered G-4569, requires an additional \$5 recording fee.

Items No. 4 and 12 on the application describe the location of this project in Township 22 South, Range 31 East. The map submitted, however, indicates the project is located in Township 20 South, Range 31 East. Whichever is in error should be corrected.

Item No. 3 on the application designates the use as being supplemental irrigation. Therefore, item No. 18 on the application must be completed to identify the existing water right.

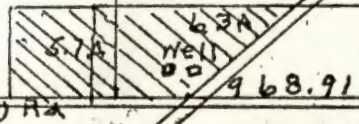

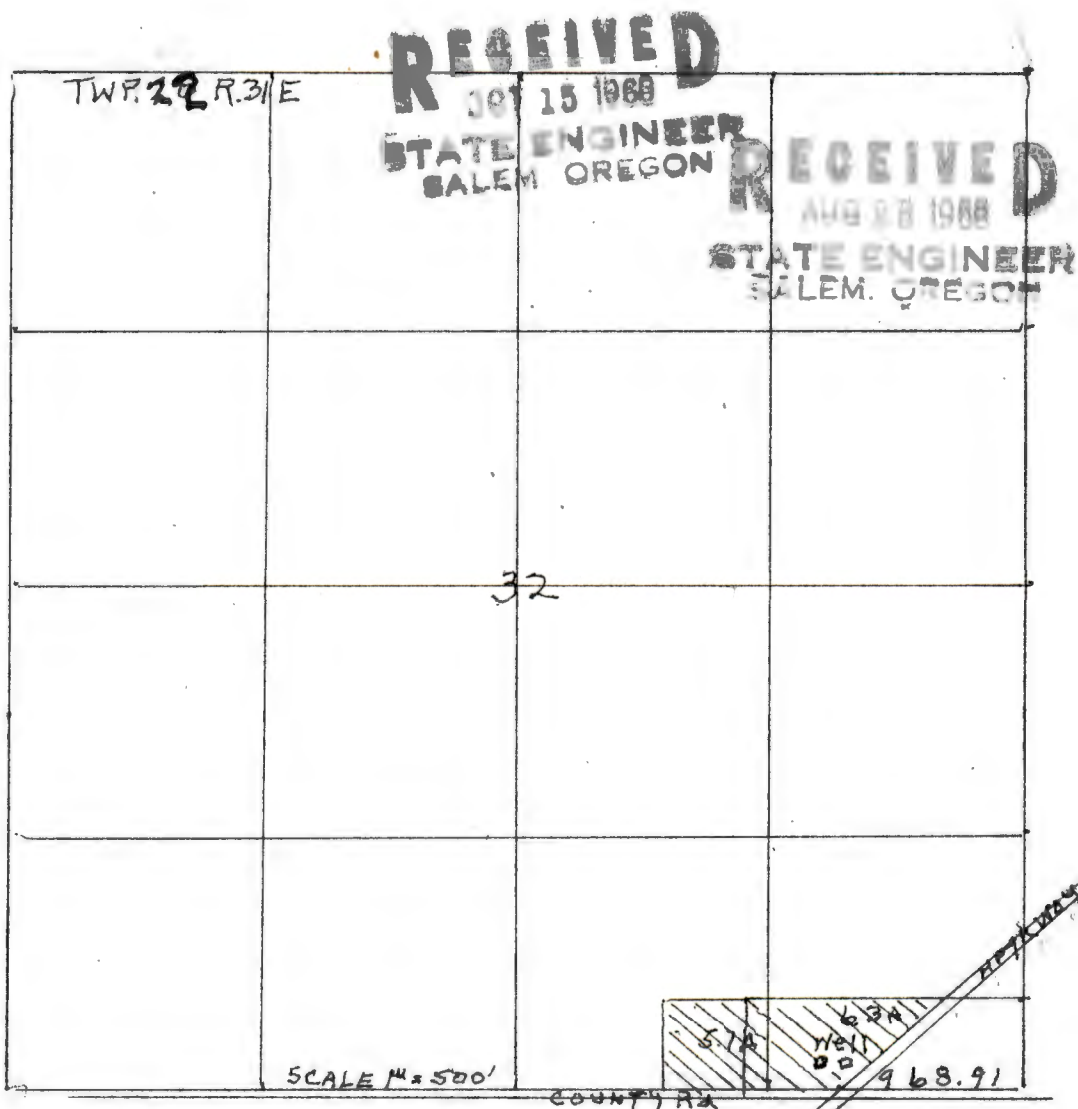
