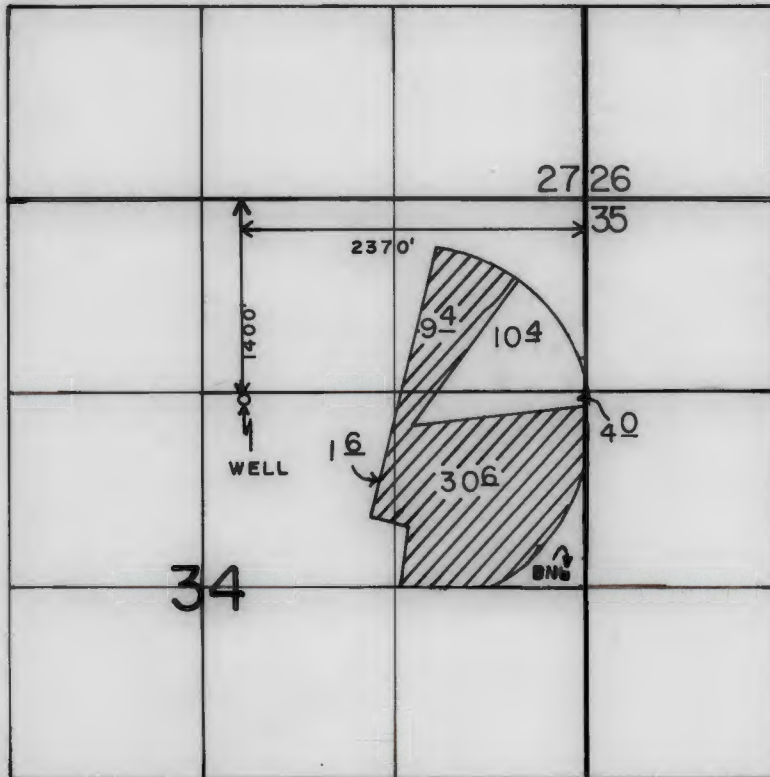

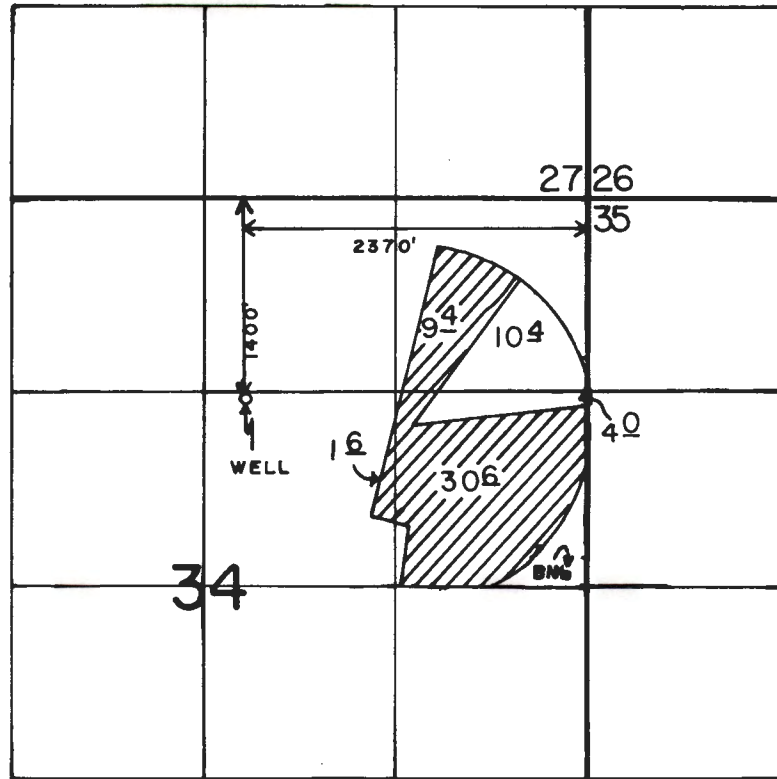

Enclosed is a proposed certificate of water right and a map which illustrates the location of the right. The map and proposed certificate represent the extent water was used within the terms of the permit based upon a survey and inspection made by a representative of this department.

If you do not agree with the proposed certificate or the map, Oregon Administrative Rule 690-11-110 allows the permittee or landowner 60 days from the mailing date of this notice to petition the Department to reconsider the contents of the proposed certificate.

If you agree with the proposed certificate and map no response to this notice is required. Shortly after the 60 day period, the recorded certificate of water right will be mailed to you.

Our field examiner found a total of 58.7 acres claimed irrigated in connection with Permit No. G-9937 which exceeds the limit of 41.6 acres under the permit. If you intend to establish a legal water right for the additional 17.1 acres, you will need to determine the permitting requirements for your area.

The 17.1 acres overacreage is displayed on the map copy as an unhatched area. If this area is not located where you prefer it to be, please notify us as it may be possible to locate the area elsewhere on your lands.

However, you will be required to submit a static water level measurement of the well on the ten-year anniversary of the test you conducted.


The Department has also reviewed your request for exemption for the additional wells listed above based on the results of the tested well. Our review indicates that the tested well and the wells proposed for exemption:

- . are located within a five-mile radius and
- . appear to be completed in the same water-bearing zone.

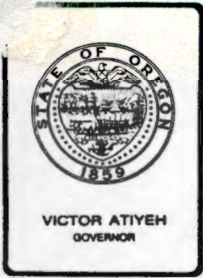

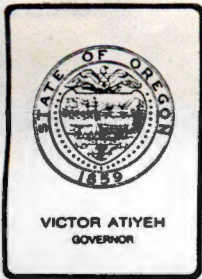

It will be necessary for you to complete Items 1, 4 and 5 describing the requested information regarding the well.

Agricultural use as described in Item 7 does not clearly define your intended use of water. If you intend to use the water for the irrigation of crops, you should enter "irrigation" in Item 7.

I am returning your application and map for correction and completion. Your application is endorsed so that in order to retain its priority date, it must be received in this office on or before November 15, 1982.
