Authority

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

1. On October 17, 2014, CURT BLACKBURN filed an application to change the points of appropriation and add additional points of appropriation under Certificates 35135, 36880, 49683, 83994, and 89445. The Department assigned the application number T-11906.
2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on October 28, 2014, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
3. On November 4, 2014, the Department emailed the agent notifying them of the deficiencies in the application.
4. On November 19, 2014, the agent submitted a revised application and map correcting the deficiencies.
5. On July 21, 2015, the Department emailed the agent notifying them of the deficiencies in the application.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

6. On July 22, 2015, the agent submitted a revised application and map correcting the deficiencies.
7. On December 2, 2015, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-11906 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of January 4, 2016, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the completion date be extended to October 1, 2022 and for the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.
8. On February 17, 2015, the Department issued a Preliminary Détermination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-11906 and sent a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published in the Department's weekly notice on February 23, 2016, and in the Burns Times Herald newspaper on February 24 and March 2, 2016, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notices.

Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

19. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
20. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-11906.
21. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the rights.
22. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights
23. All other application requirements are met.

Conclusions of Law

The change in points of appropriation and additional points of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-11906 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.


Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The change in points of appropriation and additional points of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-11906 are approved.
2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 35135, 36880, 49683, 83994, and 89445 and any related decree.
3. Water right Certificates 83994 and 89445 are cancelled.
4. Water right Certificates 35135, 36880, and 49683 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued describing those portions of the rights not affected by this transfer.

5. The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation.
6. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
7. If substantial interference with a senior water right occurs due to withdrawal of water from any well listed in this transfer, then use of water from the well(s) shall be discontinued or reduced and/or the schedule of withdrawal shall be regulated until or unless the Department approves or implements an alternative administrative action to mitigate the interference. The Department encourages junior and senior appropriators to jointly develop plans to mitigate interferences.
8. If the number, location, source, or construction of any well deviates from that proposed in the transfer application or required by permit conditions, this transfer may be subject to cancellation, unless the Department authorizes the change in writing.
9. Prior to using water from any well listed in this transfer, the applicant shall ensure that the well has been assigned an OWRD Well Identification Number (Well ID). A tag showing the Well ID shall be permanently attached to the well. If a well does not have a Well ID, the applicant shall apply for one from the Department and attach it to the well within 60 days of the date the transfer is approved. The Well ID shall be used as a reference in any correspondence regarding the well, including any reports of water use, water level, or pump test data.
10. Dedicated Measuring Tube: Wells with pumps shall be equipped with a minimum 3/4-inch diameter, unobstructed, dedicated measuring tube pursuant to figure 200-5 in OAR 690-200. If a pump has been installed prior to the issuance of this transfer, and if static water levels and pumping levels can be measured using an electrical tape, then the installation of the measuring tube can be delayed until such time that water levels cannot be measured or the pump is repaired or replaced.
11. Before water use may begin, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter at each point of appropriation. The totalizing flow meter must be installed and maintained in good working order. In addition, the water user shall maintain a record of all water used each month, including the total number of hours of pumping, the total quantity pumped, and the categories of beneficial use to which the water is applied. During the period of the limited license, the record of use shall be submitted to the Department annually, or more frequently as may be required by the Director, and shall be submitted to the Watermaster upon request.

12. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.
13. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2022**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
14. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.





Authority

Findings of Fact

1. On October 17, 2014, CURT BLACKBURN filed an application to change the points of appropriation and add additional points of appropriation under Certificates 35135, 36880, 49683, 83994, and 89445. The Department assigned the application number T-11906.
2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on October 28, 2014, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
3. On November 4, 2014, the Department emailed the agent notifying them of the deficiencies in the application.
4. On November 19, 2014, the agent submitted a revised application and map correcting the deficiencies.
5. On July 21, 2015, the Department emailed the agent notifying them of the deficiencies in the application.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

6. On July 22, 2015, the agent submitted a revised application and map correcting the deficiencies.
7. On December 2, 2015, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-11906 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of January 4, 2016, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the completion date be extended to October 1, 2022 and for the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.
8. On February 17, 2015, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-11906 and sent a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published in the Department's weekly notice on February 23, 2016, and in the Burns Times Herald newspaper on February 24 and March 2, 2016, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notices.

Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

19. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
20. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-11906.
21. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the rights.
22. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights
23. All other application requirements are met.

Conclusions of Law

The change in points of appropriation and additional points of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-11906 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.


Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The change in points of appropriation and additional points of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-11906 are approved.
2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 35135, 36880, 49683, 83994, and 89445 and any related decree.
3. Water right Certificates 83994 and 89445 are cancelled.
4. Water right Certificates 35135, 36880, and 49683 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued describing those portions of the rights not affected by this transfer.

5. The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation.
6. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
7. If substantial interference with a senior water right occurs due to withdrawal of water from any well listed in this transfer, then use of water from the well(s) shall be discontinued or reduced and/or the schedule of withdrawal shall be regulated until or unless the Department approves or implements an alternative administrative action to mitigate the interference. The Department encourages junior and senior appropriators to jointly develop plans to mitigate interferences.
8. If the number, location, source, or construction of any well deviates from that proposed in the transfer application or required by permit conditions, this transfer may be subject to cancellation, unless the Department authorizes the change in writing.
9. Prior to using water from any well listed in this transfer, the applicant shall ensure that the well has been assigned an OWRD Well Identification Number (Well ID). A tag showing the Well ID shall be permanently attached to the well. If a well does not have a Well ID, the applicant shall apply for one from the Department and attach it to the well within 60 days of the date the transfer is approved. The Well ID shall be used as a reference in any correspondence regarding the well, including any reports of water use, water level, or pump test data.
10. Dedicated Measuring Tube: Wells with pumps shall be equipped with a minimum 3/4-inch diameter, unobstructed, dedicated measuring tube pursuant to figure 200-5 in OAR 690-200. If a pump has been installed prior to the issuance of this transfer, and if static water levels and pumping levels can be measured using an electrical tape, then the installation of the measuring tube can be delayed until such time that water levels cannot be measured or the pump is repaired or replaced.
11. Before water use may begin, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter at each point of appropriation. The totalizing flow meter must be installed and maintained in good working order. In addition, the water user shall maintain a record of all water used each month, including the total number of hours of pumping, the total quantity pumped, and the categories of beneficial use to which the water is applied. During the period of the limited license, the record of use shall be submitted to the Department annually, or more frequently as may be required by the Director, and shall be submitted to the Watermaster upon request.

12. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.
13. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2022**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
14. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.

Pursuant to your request I have enclosed some Forms A, B and C for your use as required.

Mr. Pen had previously submitted the completion of construction notices, but from one of his letters, it was difficult to know whether he was referring to just the construction of the well or to the construction of both the well and the necessary facilities to make use of water.
