The Department has been reviewing the Claim of Beneficial Use (claim) report and map, received on March 5, 1997. The Department is prepared to issue a proposed certificate for this permit; however the Department has identified an issue that must be resolved before the issuance of a certificate.

The Department has identified Nichols as the new landowner for Tax Lots 100 and 201, for properties located in Section 29. The Department has identified Lamb as the new landowner for Tax Lots 3400, 3501, and 3700. The Department currently has and approved a pump test for Well No. 1 (Lamb). In order to issue the DRAFT Certificate (attached), the Department needs a pump test for Well No. 2 (Nichols).

The Pump Test requirement for the permit has not yet been satisfied. Oregon Administrative Rule 690-217-0020(1) requires that ground water permit holders with a priority date on or after December 20, 1988 submit the results of a pump test for each well listed in your claim of beneficial use before a water right certificate can be issued. These rules also allow the well owner to request one of two types of exemptions related to the testing of the well(s). The first type of exemption request is for an "Unreasonable Burden." This exemption can be requested if testing the well(s) would place an unreasonable burden on the well owner (OAR 690-217-0015(3) and (4)). Examples could include a) an economic hardship or b) the test would cause an interruption of services to customers or possible other necessary uses from the well (domestic, livestock, ect.). The second exemption request allows an owner with multiple wells to request that a qualifying, previously approved pump test on one of their wells be used to satisfy the requirement for additional wells under their ownership (OAR 690-217-0020(3)). No fee is required to request either type of exemption. Exemptions must be requested in writing using one of the two exemption forms before being considered. A one page description of the Pump Test Program along with the necessary forms to request either type of exemption or perform the test is attached. If your name is not listed on the draft certificate, and you are the current landowner, and would like to have the final certificate issued in your name, you may apply through the Department to have the permit assigned to you. My understanding of the Pump Test Exemption process is that the tested well and the well for which the exemption is being requesting must be under the same ownership. If the wells are currently under separate ownership, the exemption would not work. If Mr. Davis were to purchase the property so that both wells were under his ownership, then he would meet the ownership element of the exemption. He would still need to demonstrate that the wells were within 5 miles and in the same aquifer.

Thank you for submitting the Pump Test for well HARN 1393. I have logged the test into our system and will forward a copy to the Groundwater Section for review. The Claim indicates that there are two wells that were developed under the permit. At some point, either a second test will need to be submitted for the second well or, if the permit holder qualifies, following an approval of the Pump Test request a multiple well exemption (see OAR 690-217-0020(3)).

In order to request a multiple well exemption, the permit holder will need to request the exemption in writing. The request must include the information identified in OAR 690-217-0020(3):

“If a landowner owns multiple wells producing from the same aquifer and has tested one of those wells, he may request exemptions for all other of those wells which are within five miles of the tested well and which produce water from the same aquifer. If a well is more than five miles from the tested well, or produces from a different aquifer, it must be tested separately. Requests for exemptions shall be in writing and include water well reports or other documentation showing the water producing zones for each well.”

This permit is issued approving Application G-12664. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 24, 1991. The use is limited to not more than 3.23 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS) BEING 1.675 CFS FROM WELL NO. 1 AND 1.555 CFS FROM WELL NO. 2, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- C. The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 28, 1996 and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1997. Complete application of water shall be made on or before October 1, 1998.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.



Oregon Administrative Rule 690-217-0020(1) requires that ground water permit holders with a priority date after December 20, 1988, submit the results of a pump test before the Water Resources Department can issue a water right certificate. A copy of your permit is enclosed. The purpose of this letter is to remind you of the pump test requirement.

Pump tests are intended to provide aquifer and well information for ground water resource characterization and to help solve well problems. There is no penalty for not submitting a pump test.

If there is a reason why a pump test cannot be performed on a well, the owner may request from the Director an exemption from the pump test requirement. Requests shall be in writing and include the reason why a pump test cannot be performed. Exemptions, or conditioned exemptions, shall be granted if the reasons are found to be valid and eliminating the problem would place an unreasonable burden on the well owner. Exemptions shall be granted for public water supply wells if pump testing will cause interruption of service to customers.

Pump tests shall not be required of wells with diameters greater than 36 inches and depths less than 30 feet. Pump tests shall not be required of collector-type wells or infiltration galleries. If your well meets one of these two requirements please let us know.

I talked to Tom Davis about the need for a measuring device or another method of measuring his use. If he uses his pump GPM and figures the usage from his power bills for the season and they are separate for each well, they could satisfy the reporting requirement when needed. I assisted Tom in figuring his usage for 1995 and 1996. Well #1 used 1.71 acf in 1995, 2.25 acf in 1996. Well #2 used 1.23 acf in 1995 and 2.36 acf in 1996.

The in line meeters are expensive and do not last depending on the size and pressure in the lines. The wells in this area are very stable and recharge even in the drought years. At some future date a positive meter may be needed.

PUBLIC INTEREST REVIEW

The proposed water use described in Application #G-12664 has been evaluated according to the public interest standards set out in ORS 537.170 and OAR 690-11-195.

The Report of Technical Review for Application #G-12664 proposes allocation of 3.23 CFS from TWO WELLS within the WARNER LAKES Basin for the purpose(s) of IRRIGATION OF 258.4 ACRES. The Technical Review Report limits the proposed use to IRRIGATION DURING THE PERIOD MARCH 1 THROUGH OCTOBER 31.

The proposed use described in Application #G-12664 is not within a category required to be submitted to the Commission.

The Director of the Water Resources Department has evaluated the Application for the proposed water use and made the following public interest determination.

TECHNICAL REVIEW

Water use Application #G-12664 received a Satisfactory Report of Technical Review.

The Technical Review revealed that the proposed water use:

- a)-is not prohibited by statute or scenic waterway criteria;
- b)-is a classified use under the applicable basin program or an application for the use has been filed under ORS 536.295 and OAR 690 Division 82;
- c)-is consistent with conditions previously imposed by the Commission on appropriations from the same source;
- d)-will not conflict with (an) existing water right(s);
- e)-is supported by an available source of water.

**PUBLIC INTEREST REVIEW
CHECKLIST**

The Director of the Water Resources Department has evaluated the proposed water use, as described in Application #G-12664, in light of current and planned uses and reasonably anticipated future demands for water from the water source as established in the record.

✓ An applicant for municipal water use has submitted information showing the proposed water use is compatible with comprehensive plan policies concerning urban services, urban growth boundaries, and Public Facilities Plans.

III. Identified environmental concerns.

- ✓ The proposed water use does not appropriate water from any water body listed to receive Total Maximum Daily Loads and therefore, the water body has not been defined as water quality limited according to Section 303(d)(1) of the federal Clean Water Act according to the information supplied by the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality.

- d) The amount of waters available for appropriation for beneficial use.
- e) The prevention of wasteful, uneconomic, impracticable or unreasonable use of the waters involved.
- f) All vested and inchoate rights to the waters of this state or to the use of the waters of this state, and the means necessary to protect such rights.
- g) The state water resources policy formulated under ORS 536.295 to 536.350 and 537.505 to 537.525.





 - B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided

however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

7. Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.
8. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.
9. Failure to comply with any of the provisions of the permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, penalties, or cancellation of the permit.



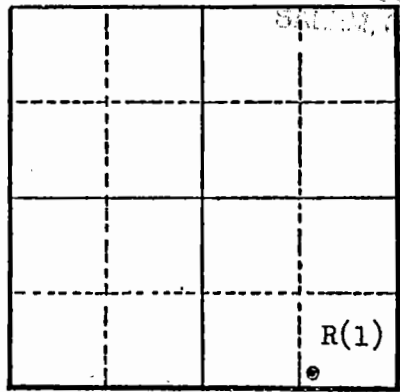
