
#### **Background**

1. On December 23, 2020, the permit holder submitted an “Application for Extension of Time” (Application) to the Department, requesting both the time to complete construction of the water system and the time to apply water to full beneficial use under the terms and conditions of Permit G-11578 be extended from October 1, 2020, to October 1, 2025.
2. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on May 25, 2021, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to deny the time to complete construction to October 1, 2025, and the time to apply water to beneficial use to October 1, 2025. The protest period closed July 9, 2021, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1).
3. On June 18, 2021, John Short, agent for the permit holder, submitted a request to withdraw the Application for Extension of Time.

#### **Order**

The Application for Extension of Time submitted December 23, 2020, is withdrawn.
