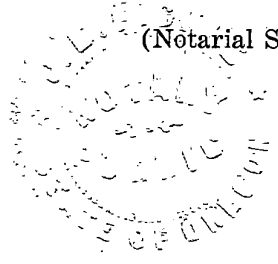

Dear Sir:

Referring again to the matter of making final proof under permits No. 9, 10, and 11, for the waters of springs for domestic supply for the City of Gardiner, we will be glad to forward final proof blanks under these permits, but on going over the records we find no maps showing the location of these springs. However, in all the permits the point of diversion and termination is given as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 22, T. 21 S. R. 12 West. If you have a copy of the map filed with these applications, we would be glad to have same for our files and final proof blanks will be forwarded you as soon as possible.

I am returning herewith a tracing that you forwarded to this office some time ago for the reason that we are unable to find just which permit this tracing should be filed with. If you will return the tracing together with the number of the permit, we will be glad to place the same on record. In your letter transmitting the tracing to this office you said it should be filed with an application forwarded to this office about October 25, 1915. We do not have an application from you of that date. Your application No. 4304 was received June 3, 1915, and your application No. 4702 was received December 31, 1915. However, application No. 4304 is for the water of a spring in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 7, but not in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 7.

We would be glad to have you help us straighten these matters in order that our records may be brought up to date.
