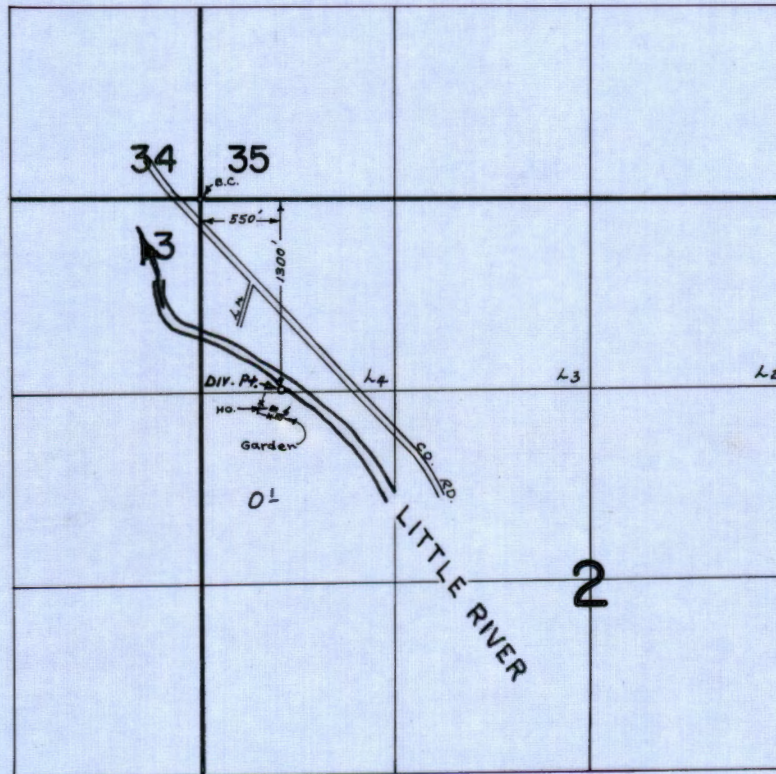

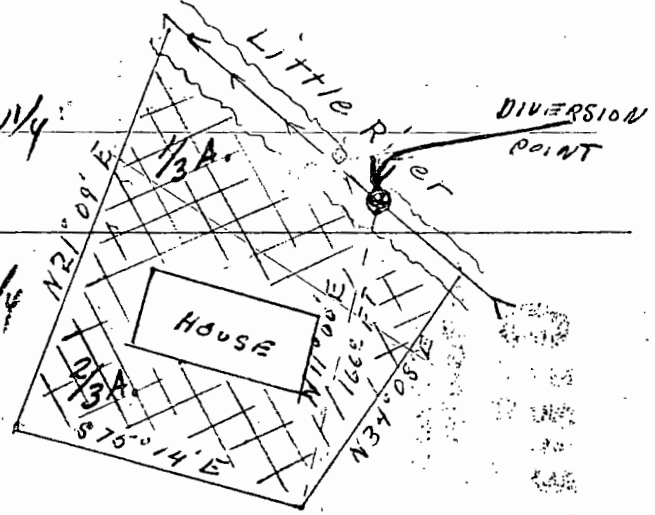

A strip of land 12 feet in width adjacent to the real property surveyed in that certain survey by G. M. Lecklider Engineer dated September 1957 for Hansen Lumber Company, filed with the County Surveyor October 9, 1957, on the Westerly side thereof beginning at the initial point of said description as the Southeasterly corner of said 12 foot strip running thence North along the boundary of said surveyed parcel of land North 19° 58' East to the center of the East fork of the North Umpqua River, commonly known as Little River, for the purpose of installing and maintaining thereon a roadway for access for benefit of the parcel of land described above as Parcel 1, and all parts thereof, to Little River County Road and including the bridge installed across Little River. 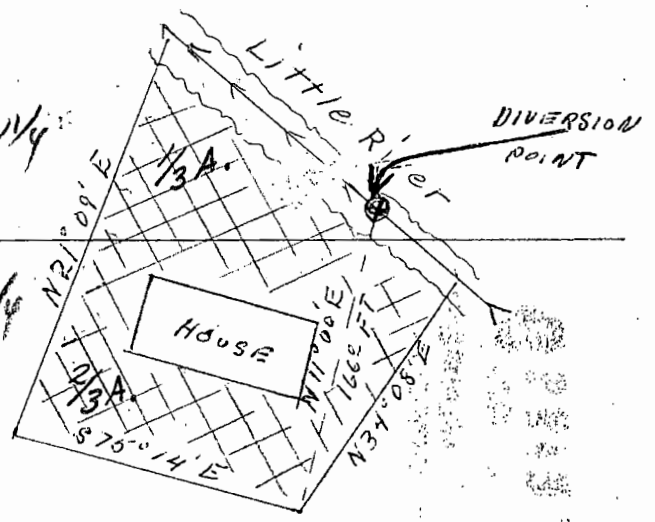




