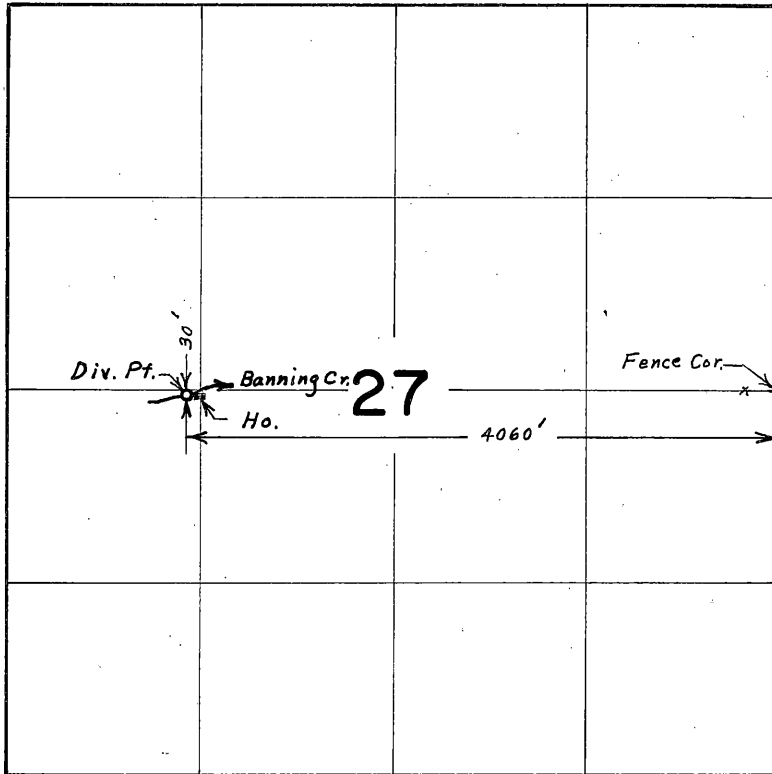

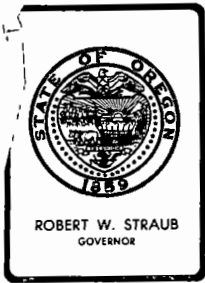

This is in response to your letter of Dec. 4 1978. I still desire to have the water permit for 1000 Spherator Dr. Williams Oregon.

I have sent the assignment form to Mrs. Million to sign. Hopefully this will facilitate the process of getting the permit in my name. Please let me know if you don't receive the signed form from Mrs. Million of 603 Sunset way, Grants Pass Oregon. 97526.

In response to your field engineer report; I will try to explain the water situation at 1000 Spherator Dr.

We have a hand dug well perhaps 14-16 feet deep, no more than 15 feet from Banning creek. The well is now dry and was dry when we purchased the property. The well is no more than a hole with a few concrete

Culverts stacked on top of one another.

The pump on top of the "Well" pulls water directly out of the creek and pumps it to the house some 35 feet away. This is our only water source. It is good clean year-round water. We have a small garden and do water directly around our house during extreme fire season.

We must cooperate with you so we can maintain our household water flow.

I may add that normally only two people, my wife and myself, occupy the house. at the present time Mr. David Cobb his wife and daughter live in the house. This will continue for some months while I am in Mass. on Business. Please respond if there are any problems. Sincerely

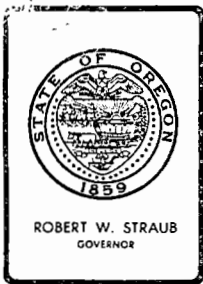

Dear Mr. Troutt:

Thank you for your check in the amount of \$2. and your letter regarding permit No. 32736. We are unable to take action on your request because the information does not satisfactorily meet our requirements.

The statutes only provide for the record holder of a permit to assign their interest in the permit to someone else. We recently changed our records, November 16, 1978, to show Ms. Debbie Million as holder of the permit. Perhaps for all concerned, it would be better for her to sign the enclosed form and return it so that we can again change our records. The addresses we have for Ms. Million are as follows: 1000 Sheraton Drive, Williams, OR 97544; and 1335 Allston Way, Berkeley, CA 94702.

Occasionally we have not been able to obtain the signature of the record holder and we have used a certified copy of the deed showing the present owner as legal owner of the property in question. The instrument you submitted to us only describes a piece of property, which, incidentally, does not describe the entire property as described on the legal description which accompanied the application for a permit. For this reason, as well as the adverse report submitted by our field engineer, I would really hesitate on changing our records with anything other than the signature of Debbie Million.

Our field engineer reported that water was being appropriated from two different places, one of which the engineer referred to as a well, but could be the infiltration system you mentioned; and the other source was Banning Creek. The permit granted the right to appropriate water from Banning Creek at a point located 180 feet south and 1280 feet east from the West Quarter Corner of Section 27; and the use was for domestic supplies for one family including the irrigation of lawn or garden not exceeding $\frac{1}{2}$ acre in area. Under the terms of the permit, only one system was to have been developed for household supplies and any irrigation would have to be made through the same system. The permit, however, is entirely dependent upon the use of water for domestic supplies. If

use of water is not being made as allowed under permit No. 32736, the permit should be canceled. An application for a new permit for the use of water as it is being made could then be submitted.

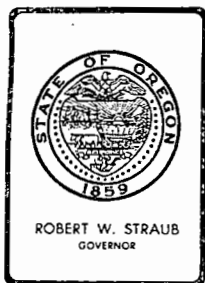

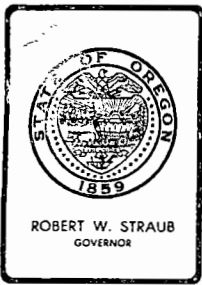

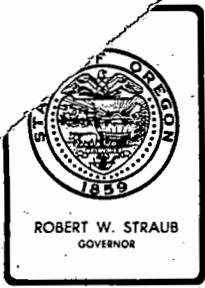

Dear Ms. Watson,

On September 16, 1975, our field engineer made an inspection of the project described in your permit 32736. As you are aware, permit 32736 granted the right to the use of 0.01 cubic foot per second of water from Banning Creek for domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre in area.

Domestic use has not been defined by Oregon Law but it is generally accepted to mean household use of water only. If one intends to water a lawn or small garden through spigots connected to the house, the application for a permit should be worded accordingly. In this case, use of water for irrigation purposes is entirely dependent upon the use of water for household supplies. According to the engineer's report, a well has been constructed and water is being appropriated from the well for domestic supplies. A separate system is delivering water from Banning Creek for irrigation purposes.

A permit is not required to appropriate water from a well when 15,000 gallons of water per day or less is used for domestic supplies. The watering of a lawn or non-commercial garden not exceeding $\frac{1}{2}$ acre in area, from a well, may be done also without a permit. The use of water, as determined by our field inspection, is not being made within the terms of your permit, therefore, the permit should be canceled. A partially completed form for this is enclosed. The cancellation of the permit would clear it from our records and avoid the necessity for further notices or correspondence.

In the event you wish to appropriate water from Banning Creek for irrigation purposes, a permit would be required and we will be happy to send you the necessary application forms upon request.

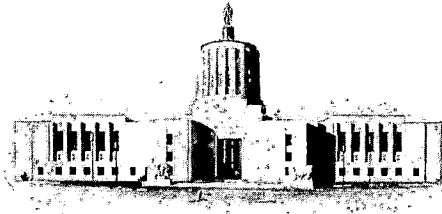

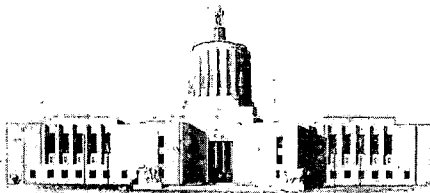

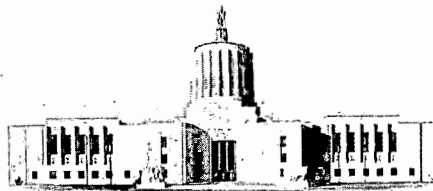

This will acknowledge receipt of your application for a permit to appropriate 0.01 cubic foot of water per second from Banning Creek for one family domestic including $\frac{1}{2}$ acre irrigation, a map, legal description, and the fee of \$25 for which our receipt No. 6586 is enclosed. This application has been filed and numbered 44231.

Your application map shows a pond located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27. 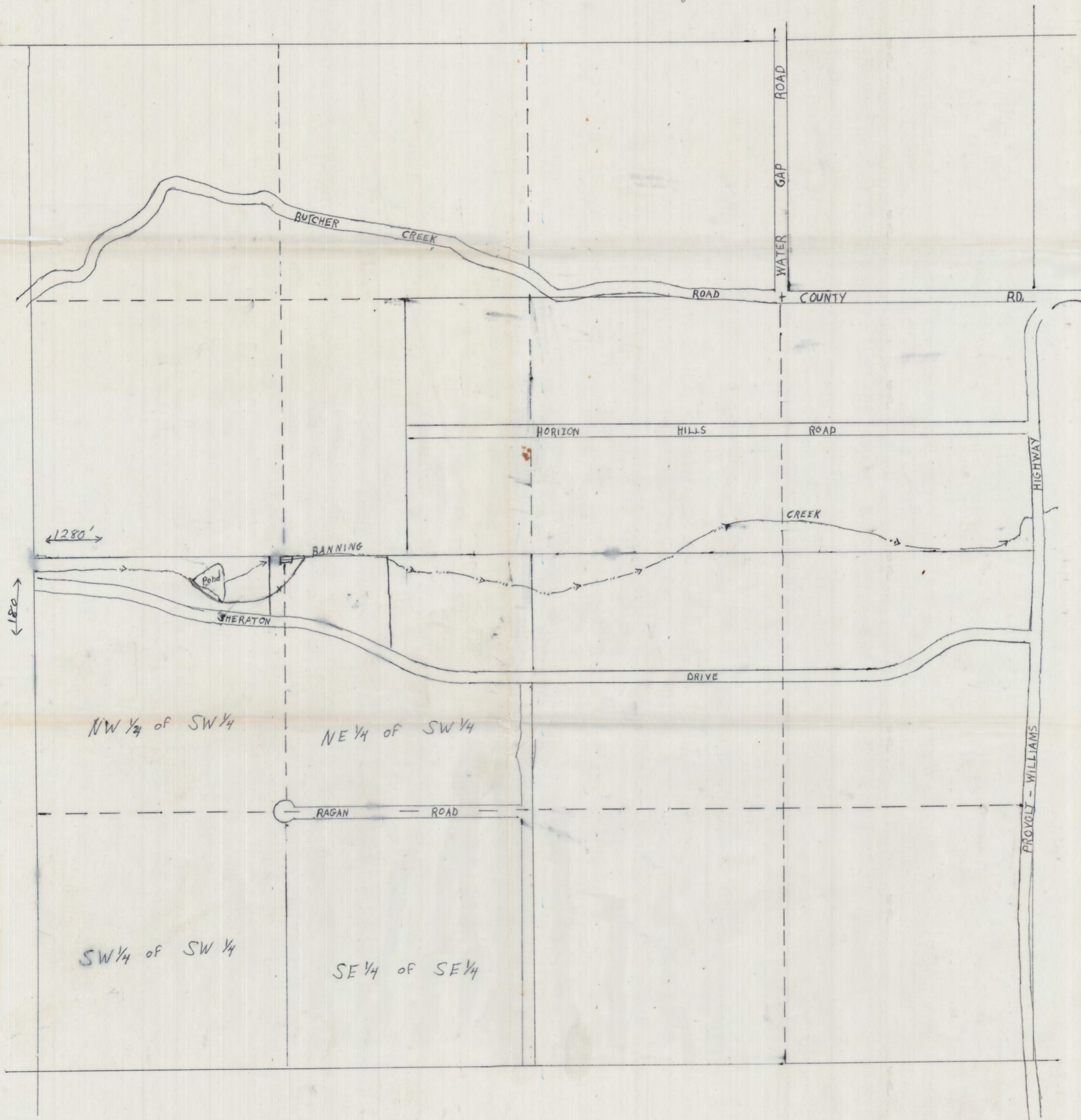

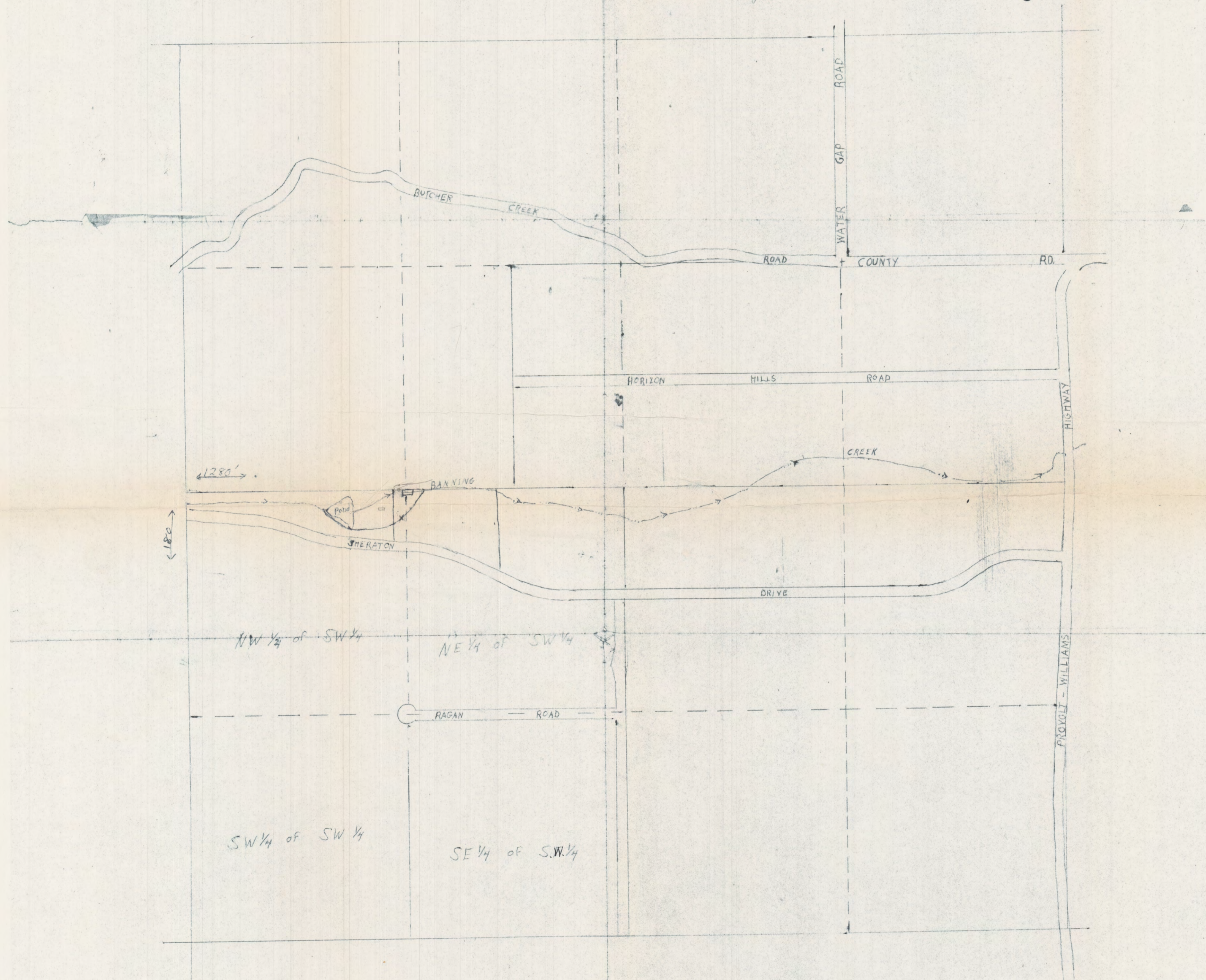
