

SUBJECT: Proof for T-5544

This transfer was filed October 1, 1984. It requested to "flip-flop" rights under Cert 2190 (priority 1915) (with Supplemental under Cert 32529) and rights under Cert 32529 (priority 1960). Also in the same area was Permit 48863 (priority 1970).

Leslie Olson, field inspector in Bend, did the final proof surveys for both the transfer and permit at the same time, in 1985.

Permit 48863 (1970) requested 7.1 acres primary irrigation in the SW SE, Section 4. The subsequent certificate (55659), issued in 1987, allowed 12.4 acres primary irrigation. Leslie on the final proof for the transfer reduced the 1960 priority acreage to 3.2 acre, rather than the 9.8 acres allowed by the transfer order. A certificate had not yet been issued for the transfer.

I discussed this with the local Watermaster. He had no problem with stacking the water rights and preserving the 1960 priority.

Based on my discussion with the Watermaster, I am recommending that the full 9.8 acres of 1960 priority water right, which has been irrigated under the terms of the transfer, be allowed on this certificate. This will cause a "stacking" of water rights from the same source, even from the same POD. That portion of the 1970 right will not ever be used again.

The other option is to work with the landowner and attempt to get the overlap portion of the 1970 priority right cancelled. This would probably cause more work than the benefit. The Watermaster says that if, in the rare event he has to regulate in that area, he will just limit both rights to the limit (1/40th and 4.0).

The 1960 right (Cert 32529) included supplemental irrigation that covered the 1915 right (Cert 2190).

From the time the transfer application was prepared, and when Leslie did the final proof survey, it appears the river moved. Leslie found less acres being irrigated in Section 9 than allowed by the transfer. She included the remainder of the 1915 right (Cert 2190) in Section 5. This could probably be considered contiguous land since it is served by the same ditch and is north of the river.

There is no evidence that the water from the 1960 right (Cert 32529) is used on the land in Section 5 from the pump. Because there is a hill which appears to come to the bank of the right, no evidence of a pipe line around the hill on the photo, and Leslie did not mention a pipe running over to that land, I believe the supplemental water was not used on the land in Section 5. I did not include supplemental irrigation in Section 5.

The irrigation limits in the permit are $1/40^{\text{th}}$ and 4. The amount of water allowed in the permit is less than $1/40^{\text{th}}$ for the resulting acreage. Nothing in the cancellation order talked about reducing the quantity of water; only the acreage. Therefore, even though the acreage was reduced, I did not reduce the quantity of water.

 CROOKED RIVER SOURCE




