I am enclosing an affidavit to provide for cancelation of that part of the water right for Lancaster Slough for irrigation of the lands described in your application for a permit to irrigate from a well.

I find no record in correspondence and I am not sure if it was discussed with you but there is another point for consideration. The original right for Lancaster Slough did not include all the lands shown on the final proof survey map as the total claimed irrigated exceeded the limits of the per-I am enclosing a print of the final proof survey map made in connection with permit 25884. The area colored blue was under the right but canceled when the permit to irrigate from two wells was obtained. The area colored green is described in the enclosed affidavit for cancelation of this part and is covered by the new application for use from two wells. The area colored yellow is that part of the original right which will remain after the cancelation being considered. The area colored red comprising 15.3 acres was not included in the certificate issued to Linda Ayres and there is no other right appurtenant to this. If the land is irrigated and the owner intends to continue irrigating it from the slough, an application for a permit can be filed and we could assist with this if no other land is to be added.

Transferring the place of use of part instead of canceling would not serve the same purpose as the existing right only provides for the appropriation of 0.305 cubic foot per second of water from the west branch of the slough and the normal limitation for irrigation of the 16.7 acres shown in yellow together with the 15.3 acres shown in red is 0.4 cubic foot per second of water.

On receipt of the enclosed affidavit signed by the property owner we will be able to issue the permit approving your application G-5544.

This will acknowledge your application for a permit to appropriate 0.72 cubic feet per second from well number 1 for the irrigation of 57.5 acres and 0.38 cubic feet per second from well number 2 for the irrigation of 30.7 acres, a map with one print, and the fee of \$44.35 for which our receipt number 23947 is enclosed. Your application has been filed and numbered G-5544.

In the remarks section of the application you indicate that the surface water supply under permit 25884 is not sufficient due to the drying up of the sloughs. If the wells are to be the primary source of water for the lands described in this application, we will prepare for your signature the necessary affidavit of abandonment to cancel Certificate 36464.

If the sloughs are to be used to the extent the water is available and the wells are to be a supplemental source, the map and Item number 12 on the application must separately identify the primary and supplemental irrigation.
