Dear Mr. Billette:

The certificate of water right issued to E. B. Ridgway recorded at Page 10648, State Record of Water Right Certificates evidenced the right to the use of 0.1 cubic foot of water per second from unnamed springs for domestic supplies and irrigation of 2.0 acres with a date of priority of October 21, 1929. The location of the house and acreage where the right is appurtenant is as illustrated on the enclosed map. According to the map, the house supplied water is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 1, Township 3 South, Range 3 West, W. M.

The above described water right is appurtenant to the place of use where the right was established, passes with the land through change of ownership, and remains valid so long as it is not lost through non-use for any five successive years. If a portion of the right has not been used for five successive years, that portion would be lost.

I am enclosing the proper application form that you may complete and submit for applying for the use of surface waters for some beneficial use. Also enclosed is our booklet of rules and regulations relative to the appropriation and use of surface water. Permits will be issued for the use of water from Chehalem Creek and its tributaries with the understanding that water may not be available during the dry periods of the irrigation season. The available water may be needed to satisfy existing rights.

If you have a right of record for the use of water from the springs and if you believe wells in the area are reducing the water available from the springs, you may contact this office. An investigation by representatives of this office would be necessary to determine if the use from wells reduces the amount of water at the springs.


