CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That

AMAND JOSEPH FISCHER

of 9496 South Bank Drive, Roseburg , State of Oregon 97470 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed one-half acre in area

under Permit No. 42062 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

May 16, 1977 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4), Section 19, T26S, R4W, WM; 50 feet North and 50 feet East from NW Corner, Lot 13, Eagle Point Estates.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ______ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
