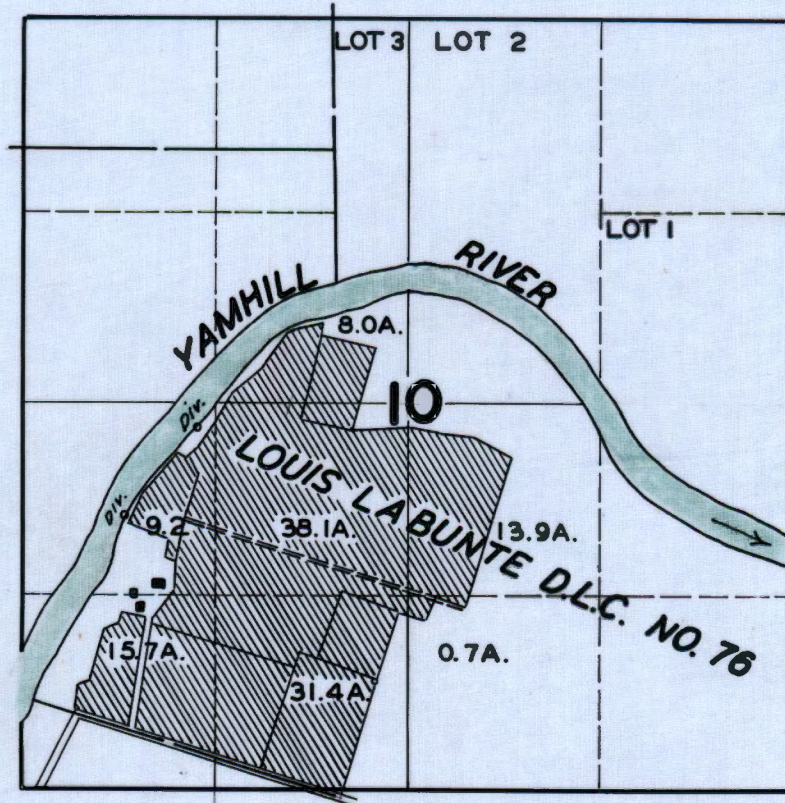

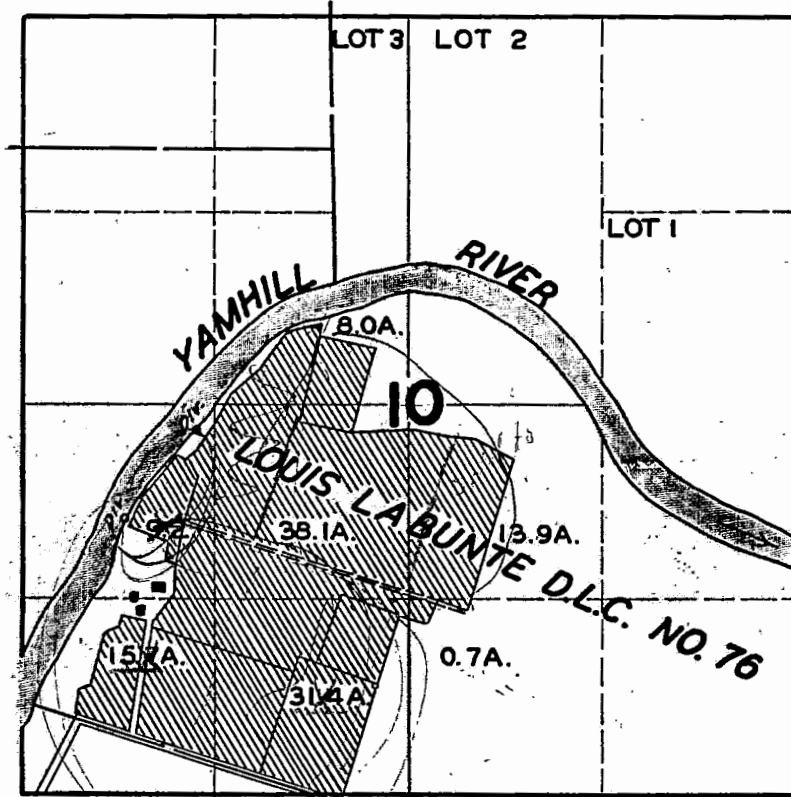

ORDER

On April 12, 1971, Byron Willard submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a water right and the lands to which the right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same to be canceled.

The water right in question is part of that evidenced by the certificate recorded at Volume 14, Page 17084, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and is for the appropriation of not to exceed 0.46 cubic foot per second of water from Yamhill River, with a priority date of August 25, 1944, for irrigation of 3.1 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 19.8 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 13.9 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 0.2 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10, Township 4 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

That part of the water right evidenced by said certificate for the appropriation of not to exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second of water from Yamhill River, with a priority date of August 25, 1944, for irrigation of 4.9 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 18.3 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 9.2 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 15.7 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 31.4 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, and 0.5 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10, Township 4 South, Range 3 West, W.M., is not in question.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the State Engineer that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancelation thereof, the State Engineer shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the water right for the

use of 0.46 cubic foot per second of water from Yamhill River with a date of priority of August 25, 1944, for irrigation of 3.1 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 19.8 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 13.9 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 0.2 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10, Township 4 South, Range 3 West, W.M., is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right recorded at Volume 14, Page 17084 is canceled and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to Willard Brothers covering that part of the water right not in question which is for the appropriation of not to exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second of water from Yamhill River, with a priority date of August 25, 1944, for irrigation of 4.9 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 18.3 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 9.2 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 15.7 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 31.4 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, and 0.5 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10, Township 4 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

This will acknowledge your letter of February 8, 1971, requesting information on water rights appurtenant to the legal description submitted.

Our records show a right for the irrigation of 30.0 acres as evidenced by certificate 23412 in the name of Dick Hess with a priority date of September 10, 1946.

Our records also show a right for the irrigation of 117.0 acres from the Yamhill River as evidenced by certificate 17084 in the name of Willard Brothers with a priority date of August 25, 1944. A part of this right is appurtenant to the lands described in the legal description. I am enclosing a copy of the final proof survey map for the Willard Brothers right showing the approximate location of your property line.

Any time the owner of a perfected water right fails to exercise that right at least once every five successive years, the right has been forfeited by nonuse. 
Gentlemen:
