

On April 12, 1971, Byron Willard submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a water right and the lands to which the right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same to be canceled.

The water right in question is part of that evidenced by the certificate recorded at Volume 14, Page 17084, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and is for the appropriation of not to exceed 0.46 cubic foot per second of water from Yamhill River, with a priority date of August 25, 1944, for irrigation of 3.1 acres in the SE_{4}^{1} NW_{4}^{1} , 19.8 acres in the NE_{4}^{1} SW_{4}^{1} , 13.9 acres in the NW_{4}^{1} SE_{4}^{1} and 0.2 acres in the SW_{4}^{1} SE_{4}^{1} , Section 10, Township 4 South, Range 3 West, W.M.




