





Enclosed please find application for the appropriation of waters of Munger Creek, supplemented by John or Mule gulch, Marble gulch and China Creek, also, plat in duplicate, and check for \$21.50 to cover fees.

The red figures in the legal subdivisions platted show, above, the acreage here requested, and below, the acreage heretofore adjudicated to the lands by the State Water Board.

The waters here applied for were in fact appropriated in about 1863 or 1864, as I remember, and were evidenced by decree in favor of the lands in question as against all the riparian owners on Munger Creek and the other tributary streams mentioned. The State Water Board has allowed water for 110 acres, and I now wish to cover with the State title the remaining 170 acres without waiver of the rights under the decree against the riparian owners, the decree being for 140 inches for the entire 280 acres.
