Dear Sir:

The Board of Control has ruled that annual proof shall be furnished by all permit holders. Forms for this purpose have been prepared marked respectively 'Notice of Beginning of Construction'', 'Notice of Completion of Construction'', 'Notice of Complete Application of Water to a Beneficial Use''.

For each year succeeding the date of approval of your permit, which date is endorsed on the back thereof, you should fill out the proper form, detach, and mail to the Secretary, Board of Control, Salem, Oregon. You will notice that these forms cover beginning of construction, completion, and application of water to beneficial use, and if more than three years is allowed for complete application of water to beneficial use, you should give on the blank marked 'Notice of Prosecution of Work with Diligence', a detailed description of the work performed each intervening year, so that the Board may judge as to whether or not the law is being complied with as to the prosecution of work with reasonable diligence. If your permit is an early one, it will be necessary to fill out and mail the first, and possibly the first and second of these forms immediately, in order to make the record complete.

Failure to fill out and mail the annual proofs required by the Board may jeopardize your rights under this permit, and result in its cancellation after proper notice, as the law provides that proof must be made "to the satisfaction of the Board of Control". The Board has ruled that final proof will not be satisfactory unless supported by annual proofs on the blanks herein submitted.

Final proof will be taken by the Board, through the proper division superintendent, as soon as possible after the expiration of time for the complete application of water to beneficial use, or any extension thereof. The Board of Control will thereafter issue a 'Certificate of Water Right', to be recorded with the county clerk of the proper county, which to your water title will correspond to a patent from the United States as foundation for your land title.

If actual construction work was not begun on or before the time limitation fixed in the endorsement of your Permit No. 791 , Application No. 1610 , your rights under this permit have lapsed, and a refiling should be made at once, if you still desire to secure a water right. The same action should be taken if the time has expired for the completion of such work, unless you have secured an extension from the Board of Control. No extension of time within which construction work must be begun can be allowed, and no extension of the time to complete work can be allowed when request is made after the time as fixed in the permit has expired, except in extreme cases.


