is to far north.

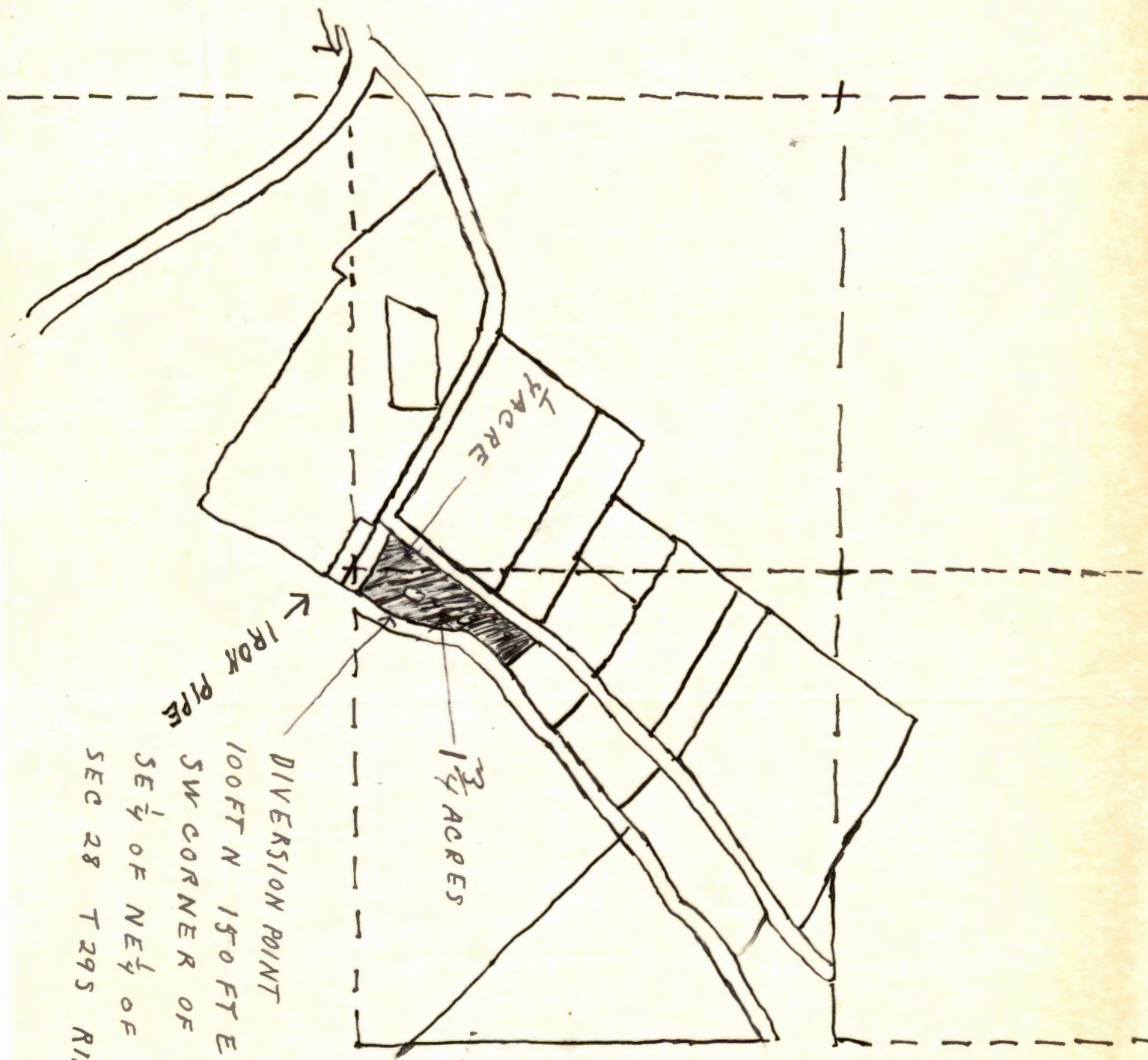

Dear Mr. Horner:

Your application for a permit to appropriate 0.0125 cubic foot of water per second for the irrigation of two acres was received along with the map prepared on tracing paper, legal description, and fees of \$25.00.

Your application has been filed as No. 51846.

The township and range that you are located within must be properly identified in item No. 4 and item No. 8. According to the legal description you submitted, your property is located within Township 29 South, Range 11 West. If so, the information supplied in the first part of item No. 4 should be completed to properly identify township and range and item No. 8 should be amended to list the range as 11 West instead of East.

According to your map, you intend to irrigate acreage within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28. If so, the number of acres you intend to irrigate in each quarter-quarter section must be noted on the map and listed in item No. 8 with respect to the proper quarter-quarter sections.

It will be necessary for you to further show on your supporting map the location of the point of diversion by distances from the reference corner to be in agreement with the information given in the first part of item No. 4. The direction North must also be noted on your map.

Applications will be accepted and permits issued for water from Coquille River and its tributaries with the understanding that there may be no water available for appropriation during the latter part of the irrigation season.
