NOTICE OF BEGINNING OF CONSTRUCTION

Permit No. Application No.

I, Hannah E. Coston, the holder of Application No. 61, being Appropriation Permit No. 24, issued by the State Engineer of the State of Oregon for the appropriation of 1/80th of one cubic foot per second per acre for 80 acres second feet of the waters of The Coston Ditch in accordance with the tenor of such permit and the limitations endorsed thereon by the State Engineer, began the actual construction of the works described thereon by the application of water to a beneficial use on the 1st day of May, 1909, being within the time limitation as fixed in said permit for the beginning of construction work.

a Dam 5 feet high and 10 feet in length on top and 8 feet long at bottom is constructed of loose rock and dirt is fully completed and two people with one team are required to put in the work

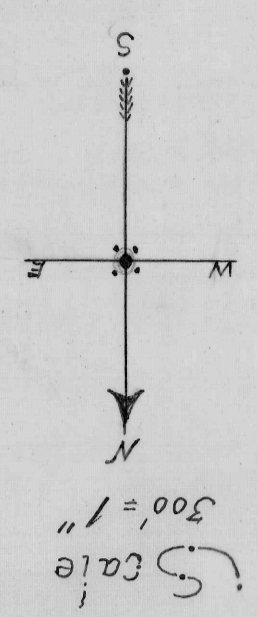

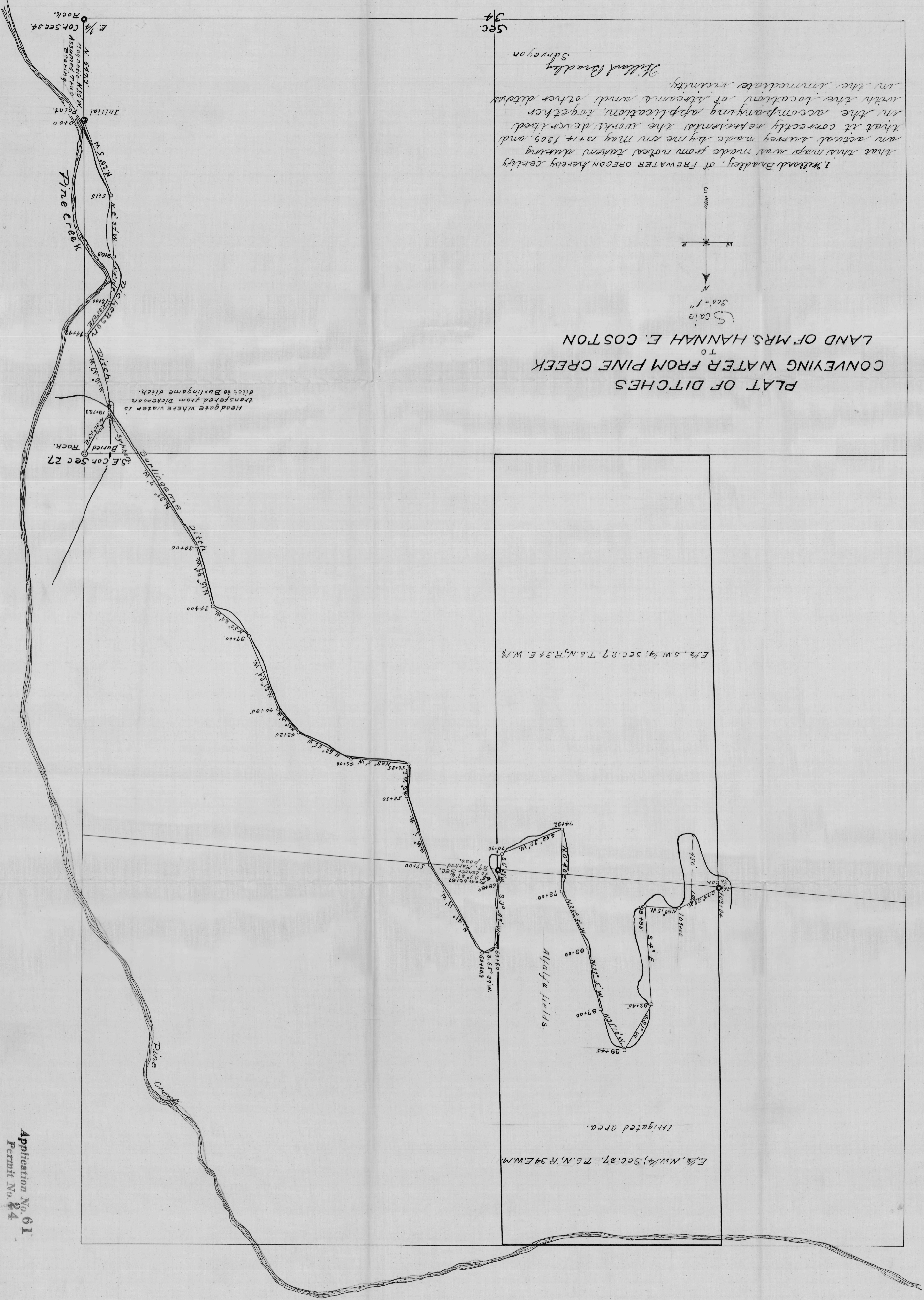
