
Proof of appropriation of water under permit No. 18,

I note from our records that you have not as yet submitted final proof under your permit No. 18, although proof blanks were again mailed you on Mar. 26, 1917. We are endeavoring to bring our records up to date and would be glad to have you submit final proof under this permit.

Your attention is called to the provisions of Sec. 7, Chapter 366, Laws of 1917, which provides that whenever the time within which any appropriation under a permit should have been perfected shall have expired and the owner of such permit shall fail or refuse within a period of 3 months thereafter to submit to the State Water Board proof of the completion of such appropriation, the Board may after 60 days notice by registered mail order the cancellation of such permit. You are therefore notified that unless hearing from you within 60 days from the date of this letter the permit will be presented to the Board for cancellation.

I note from the records of this office that you have not filed the final proof under permit No. 18 which covers the use of 0.88 second feet of water from Regain Gulch for the irrigation of 88 acres of land, although final proofs were mailed you January 12, 1916, at your request. If you have abandoned this water right and do not intend to submit final proof, we would be glad to have you authorize the cancellation of the permit on the records of this office as this will eliminate the necessity of following the regular procedure for the cancellation of the same.
