It has been brought to our attention that the City of Er in has started construction of a 22,000,000 gallon regulation receiveir, located on a sidehill above a County Road and several residences. In the event of atructural failure extensive property damage and possible loss of life would result.

This letter is to advise you that in proceeding with this work you are in violation of 683 50.350, Subsection 1, which reads as follows; We person, tire or private or municipal corporation shall construct any dam, dike, or other hydraulic structure or works, the failure of which the State Engineer finds would result in damage to life or property, unless the State Engineer has made an examination of the site and of the plans and specifications and other features involved in the construction of such works, and has approved them in writing."

You are hereby directed to cease work on this structure and that no further construction tork is to be undertaken or completed until plans and specifications have been approved, in writing, by this office.


