Appeal Rights

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183,482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Application History

On November 12, 2004, Permit R-14080was issued by the Department. The permit called the reservoir to be filled and complete application of water was to be made on or before October 1, 2009. The most recent extension authorized complete application of water to beneficial use by October 1, 2013. On August 18, 2021, Jonnie Justesen and Fred Justesen submitted an Application for Extension of Time for Permit R-14080. In accordance with OAR 690-315-

Final Order: Permit R-14080 Page 1 of 2 0050(2), on October 26, 2021, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to deny the time to apply water to full beneficial use from October 1, 2013 to October 1, 2024. The protest period closed December 10, 2021, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Department adopts and incorporates by reference the findings in the Proposed Final Order dated October 26, 2021.

At time of issuance of the Proposed Final Order the Department concluded that, based on the factors demonstrated by the applicant, the permit may not be extended.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The applicant has demonstrated good cause for the permit extension pursuant to ORS 537.230, 539.010(5) and OAR 690-315-0040(2).

ORDER

The extension of time for Application R-85194, Permit R-14080, therefore, is Denied.
