

The final order for T-13269 lists three authorized points of diversion for Certificate 42579 (POD 1, 2, and 3). As described on Certificate 42579, these PODs are associated with the following water sources authorized for use:

Unnamed Stream

- POD 1 located 50 feet North and 1420 feet West from SE corner of DLC 55
 Salt Creek
- POD 2 located 220 feet North and 1380 feet West from SE corner of DLC 55
- POD 3 located 1960 feet South and 2260 feet West from SE corner of DLC 55

HOWEVER, Certificate 42579 also lists the reservoir constructed under application R-45354 (Fidel Reservoir) as an authorized source but does not describe the location of the POD for this source. The map submitted as part of the transfer application (T-13269) identified the location of the point of diversion for the authorized reservoir source as POD 4 (located 420 feet North and 1780 feet West from SE Corner of DLC 55), but this clarification was not incorporated into the transfer final order.

The map provided with this COBU includes the location of the missing point of diversion (POD 4) for the authorized reservoir source (Fidel Reservoir).

Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Applicant

BAILEY NURSERIES, INC. 9855 NW PIKE RD YAMHILL, OR 97148

Findings of Fact

- On October 15, 2019, BAILEY NURSERIES, INC. filed an application to change the place of use under Certificates 42579 and 44240. The Department assigned the application number T-13269.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on October 29, 2019, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On January 29, 2020, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-13269 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of February 27, 2020 for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 4. On March 12, 2020, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-13269 and sent a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published in the Department's weekly notice on March 17, 2020, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.
- 5. The portion of the first right to be transferred is as follows:

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

- 9. Water has been used within the last five years. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 10. A pump, pipeline and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-13269.
- 11. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 12. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-13269 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-13269 is approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 42579 and 44240 and any related decree.
- 3. Water right Certificates 42579 and 44240 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued describing the portion of the rights not affected by this transfer.
- 4. The former place of use of the transferred rights shall no longer receive water under the rights.
- 5. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before October 1, 2021. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
