



#### ABSTRACT OF CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT NO. 13984

State of Illinois , has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Engineer of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed creeks, tributary to Williams Creek) East Fork Williams Creek a tributary of (Applegate River), for the purpose of Irrigation under Permit No. 13208 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.12 cubic foot per second, being 0.06 c.f.s. from each source,

or its equivalent in case of rotation. The point of diversion is located in the  $NE_4^1$   $SE_4^1$ , Section 3, Township 39 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

August 11, 1938

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2, to October 31, of each year, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.12 c.f.s.,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
