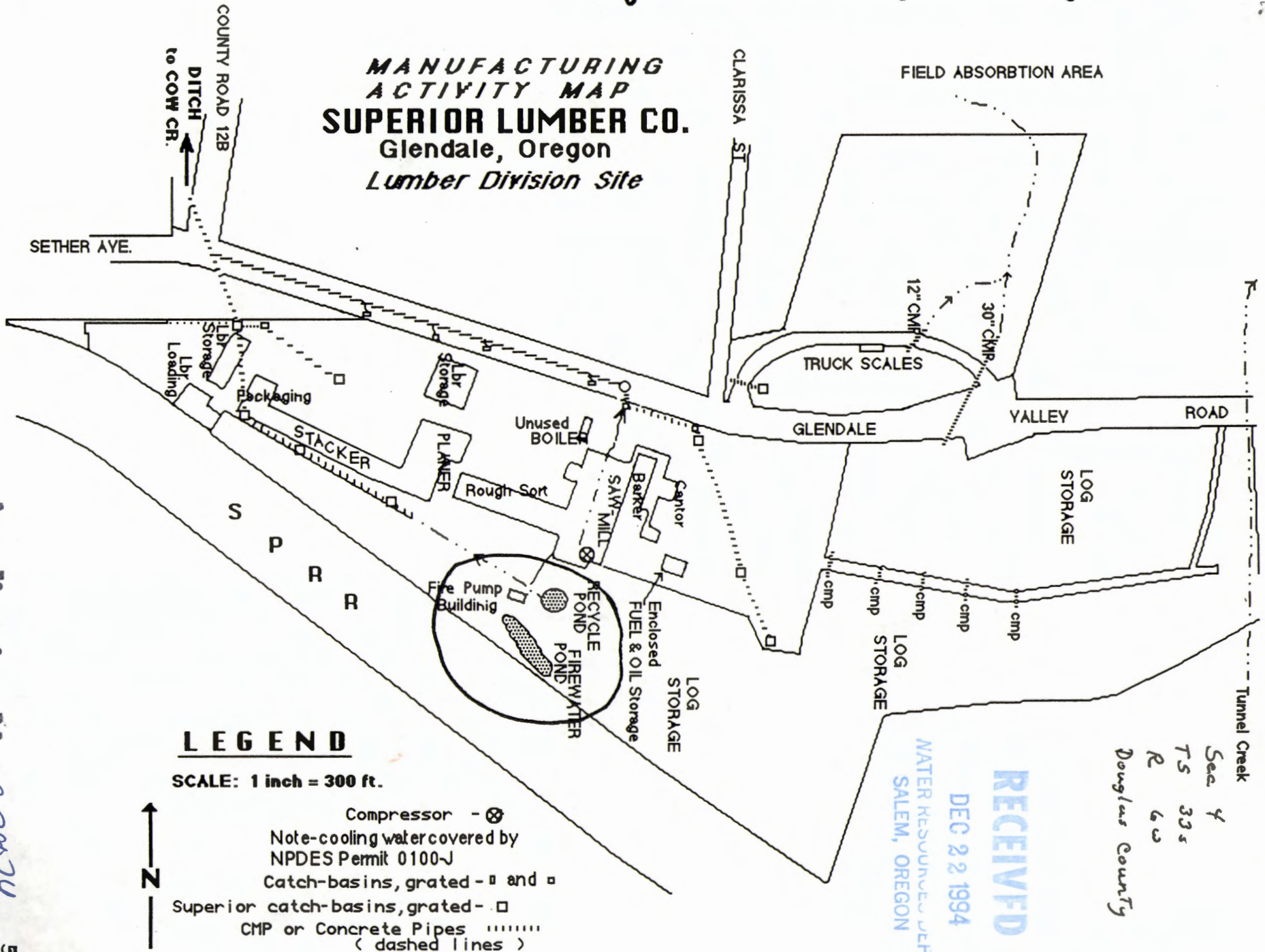

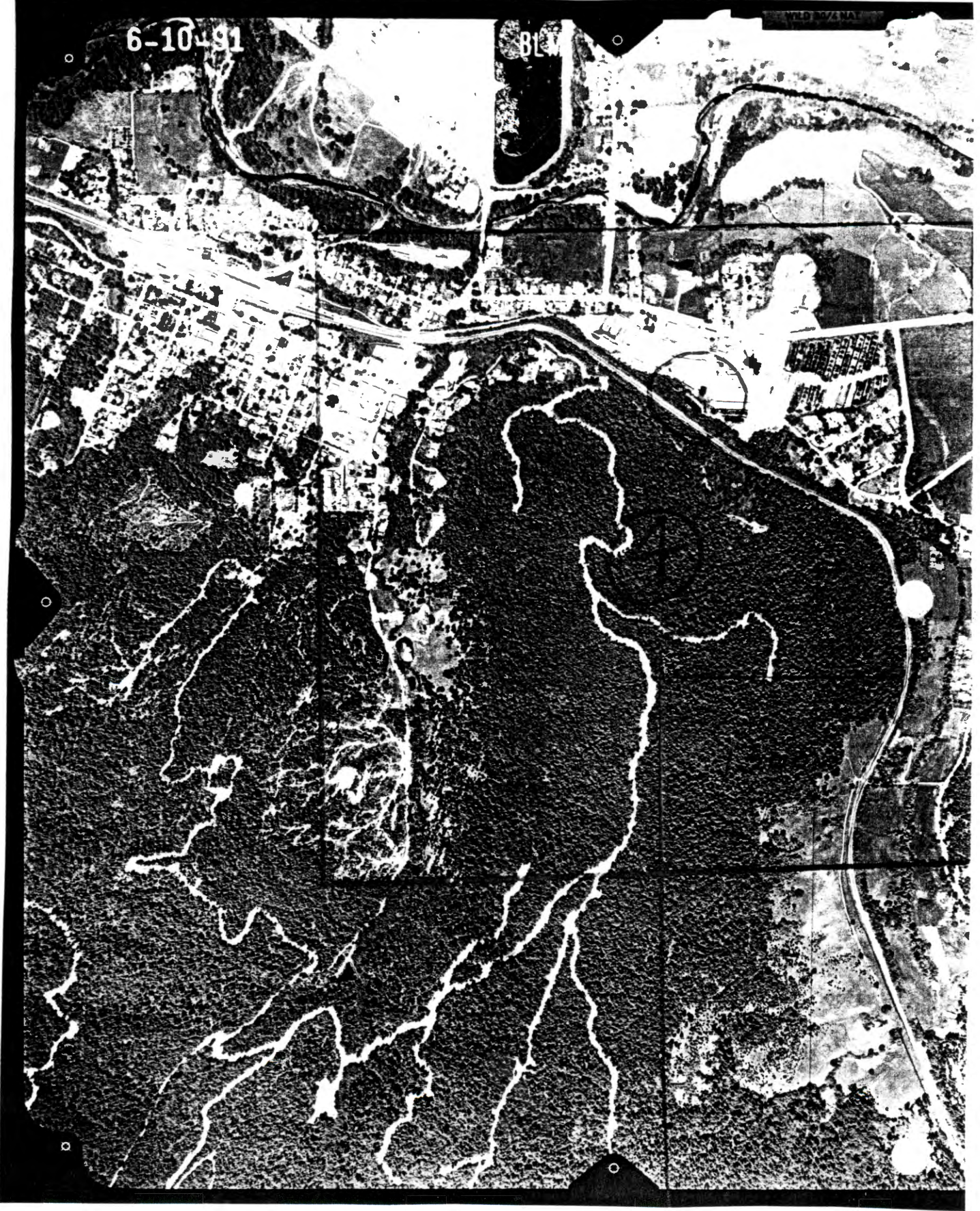

Dear Mr. French:

The Department has completed its review of the above referenced Technical Reviews of water rights applications. The drainage basin in which these applications are located has been identified as water quality limited by the Department. The estimated low flow normally occurs during the summer period of May 1st to October 31st of each year. The Department's analysis of water quality indicates that during periods of low flow, water quality problems exist.

These applications propose additional out of stream use of water which if granted would reduce available instream flows during the seasonal low flow period, thus increasing the likelihood of already identified water quality problems in this drainage basin. The Department recommends limiting the pond or reservoir water rights to high flow if it is available, and requests that this be verified with a meter when 2.0 acre feet or more are impounded. Large reservoirs covering 5 or more acres will need a DEQ stormwater permit to control runoff.

The Department requests that for pollution prevention a farm management plan be developed to address water quality issues, including: 1) possible herbicide and pesticide use in the vicinity of the pond or reservoir; 2) an erosion (sediment) plan with buffer strips; 3) a nutrient plan to prevent nitrate runoff into surface and groundwater; 4) potential flooding of the pond or reservoir if located in the 100 year floodplain with subsequent contaminant release; 5) riparian restoration and 6) a way to keep stock out of the stream.

If the pond, reservoir or diversion is designed for stock watering, operators are encouraged to establish off channel watering sites. The standard .005 Cfs or 3.62 AF per head is to be applied in requesting water. Metering for stock water is not needed. Any system established in freeze zones or other situations where water may have to be left running should provide a closed loop return system, which would allow any overflow water to return to the stream. A non point source pollution control management plan needs to be developed or the area fenced and the riparian zone replanted. In this case with these stipulations the Department would support WRD permits for year round flow in a TMDL basin.

Your exempt reservoir notice has been received by the Department and has been assigned the above-referenced file number. We would like to ask you to refer to this number if you should need to contact us about the notice, your pond, or ponds if you have more than one.


To avoid any misunderstanding, we feel it is important to tell you that although we have received and filed your notice, we have not yet determined whether you are exempt from water right requirements. The watermaster responsible for the area in which the pond(s) is (are) located will help us apply the Water Resources Commission's administrative rules to your situation. These rules set the standards that determine which ponds require water rights and which are exempt. We will let you know the results as soon as we are able to complete our review of your pond(s)'s nature.

Since the department must rely initially on the information you submit to us, it is very important that the information be complete and accurate. If inspections show that your pond(s) does (do) not qualify as exempt, you could be asked to drain the pond(s) or submit a water right application or both. If you submit your application after January 1, 1995, it will be processed like any other application, since that is the deadline for filing water rights under the pond amnesty program.

The department will process your information as quickly as possible. However, because water right processing staff members are working hard to reduce a backlog of applications, it may be some weeks before you hear from us.

If you have questions, you may contact your watermaster. The enclosed brochure lists watermaster names, telephone numbers and addresses by county.
