

Certificate of Water Right Ownership Update

NOTICE TO SELLERS & BUYERS:

By law, all water belongs to the public (ORS 537.110). In almost every instance, a permit **or** water right certificate from the Water Resources Department is needed before using, diverting or storing water (ORS 537.130). However, most domestic wells do not require water rights. A certificate of water right stays with the land. In order to keep track of water right ownership, the Department requests that this form be submitted to the Department.

Water that has been used for a long time in one place or that involves a water structure (like a dam) that already exists is no guarantee that there is a water right which would allow the water use to continue.

On behalf of the City of Cottage Grove (City), I am submitting the enclosed Certificate of Water Right Ownership Update for a <u>portion</u> of Certificate 2385. The City is conveying <u>0.23 cfs</u> of this water right to the Row River Valley Water District and requests that the Oregon Water Resources Department (OWRD) records be modified to reflect this change.

You should be aware that the City has also filed a transfer application for Certificate 2385. The City has proposed to transfer the point of diversion for all but 0.23 cfs of this water right to the City's water treatment plant on the Row River. We have requested that OWRD issue the remaining right in the name of the Row River Valley Water District, following completion of this transfer.
