I, J. Eganey Reservoir of the City of Cottage Grove holder of Application No. 136, being Permit No. 30, issued by the State Engineer of the State of Oregon, for the appropriation of six second feet of the waters of Lang Creek in accordance with the tenor of such permit and the limitations endorsed thereon by the State Engineer, have completed the construction of the works described therein the 1st day of Jan, 1912, being within the time limitation as fixed in said permit or extended by the State Water Board for the completion of construction work.

Remarks: the City has laid a pipe for 20 miles long way to be carried out
