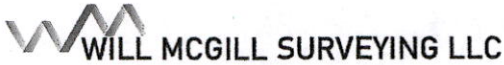

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Re: Roger Hildebrandt Transfer T-8469 COBU and accompanying transfer application

While completing the claim of beneficial use for T-8469, it was discovered that the developed and historical place of use varied slightly from what was described in the final order. Given T-8469 involved a place of use change of a supplemental right, we checked to confirm there was an overlaying primary for the 1-acre portion that varied from the final order. There was not; however, Certificate 40333 was the intended primary right.

Due to the change from overhead irrigation to a much more efficient and specific pot-in-pot system, we are transferring some of Cert. 40333 to cover the 1-acre portion and clarify the intended place of use under both rights.

Per advice from OWRD staff, we are submitting the claim and transfer simultaneously with the reasonable expectation that the transfer will have reached final order before the claim of beneficial use on T-8469 has been processed.
