I have received the final proof submitted with your letter dated May 31st in connection with Permit No. 7871 in the name of Ernest Loughridge. This proof is considered in satisfactory form and I am enclosing my receipt No. 10067 for the \$1.00 paid as certificate recording fee.

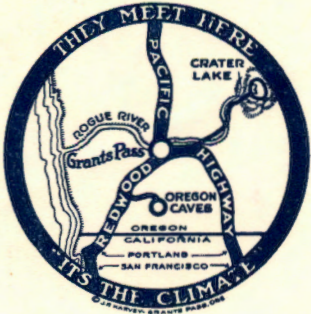
It is not possible to accomplish what you would like to do in this matter by fixing the priority of this right as February 18, 1899. The right under a permit cannot be made earlier than the date when the application is first filed in this office. The only way in which this change could be made so that Mr. Loughridge would have a proper right to pump the water from the river instead of making the diversion through the Wilderville Irrigation Company Ditch would be for him to apply for approval of a change in the point of diversion. If he does not wish to relinquish entirely his right to carry water through the ditch, he will have to accept the priority of the application which is April 11, 1927.
