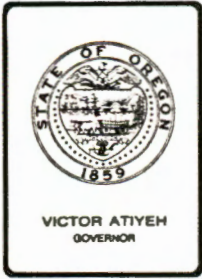

Please accept my apologies for the tardy filing of my "Application for Extension of Time." I am especially sorry that you had to take the time to write an additional letter.


My application and application fee are enclosed herewith.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.135 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Pickett Creek with any deficiency in the available supply of water to be made up by appropriation of water from the Rogue River

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for three families and irrigation, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use and 0.125 c.f.s. for irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


I was recently reviewing my Permit to Appropriate Surface Water and I noticed that the portion of the permit completed by your department contains an inaccuracy.

The permit, however, grants the right to withdraw water from Pickett Creek with any deficiency coming from the Rogue River. Little Pickett Creek and Pickett Creek are two different streams in Josephine County and both are tributaries of the Rogue River. I have access to Little Pickett Creek, but none to Pickett Creek.

Could the proper correction be made in my permit without affecting my priority date?

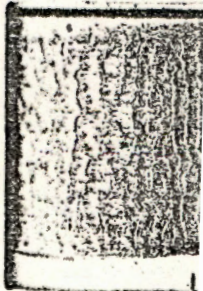

Permits will be issued for use of water from Rogue River and its tributaries. However, water may not be available during dry periods. The water may be needed to satisfy existing rights or minimum flow standards.

Your application is satisfactory and will be considered for issuance of a permit in 30 to 60 days.
