a tributary of Willamette River      for the purpose of irrigation of 3.9 acres

under Permit No. 33469      of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 15, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second

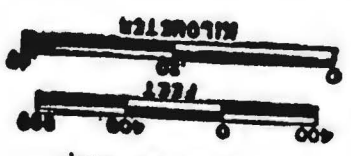


SEE MAP NO 9 9 1

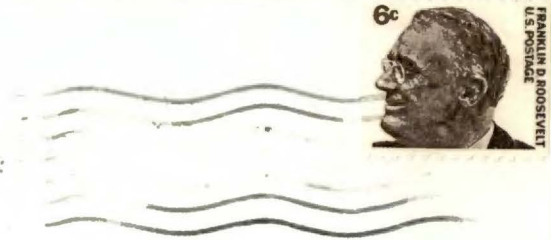

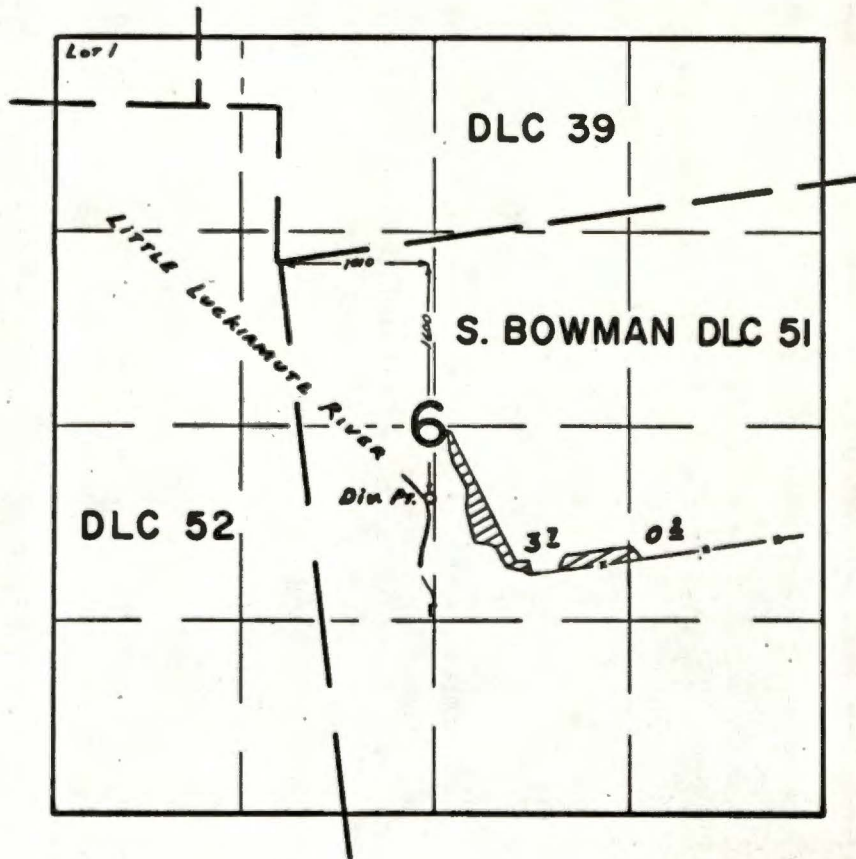
