CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That D. I. SIMMONS

of Gold Beach, State of Oregon, 97444, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of "Tommy East" Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of domestic, including irrigation of garden and lawn

under Permit No. 8505 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 15, 1928

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.1 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 20, T. 35 S., R. 12 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 4 (SE 1/4 SW 1/4) Section 20 T. 35 S., R. 12 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to supersede certificate of water right recorded on page 8528, Volume 8, State Record of Water Right Certificates so as to correctly locate the place of use.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, B. I. Simmons (Name of applicant)
of Gold Beach (Postoffice), County of Curry
State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is "Tommy East" Creek (Name of stream), tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is one cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic including irrigation of garden and lawn (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of division is located about 4 chains north and about 4 chains east of the SW corner of the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 20, T. 35 S., R. 12 W., W.M. and about 10 feet below where the County trail from Gold Beach to Agness crosses said creek.

being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 (Give smallest legal subdivision) of Sec. 20, Tp. 35 S., R. 12 W., W. M., in the county of Curry (No. N. or S.)

5. The Pipe-line (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be 800 feet miles in length, terminating in the Lot 4 (Smallest legal subdivision) of Sec. 20, Tp. 35 S., R. 12 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is The Simmons Pipe Line

7. (a) Height of dam 2 feet, length on top 6 feet, length at bottom 6 feet; material to be used and character of construction Logs and loose rock with built in box for intake (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate Board Box with 2 inch pipe intake for 80 feet to wooden storage tank on applicant's premises from which it will be carried by 3/4 inch pipe to residence a distance of 800 feet.
