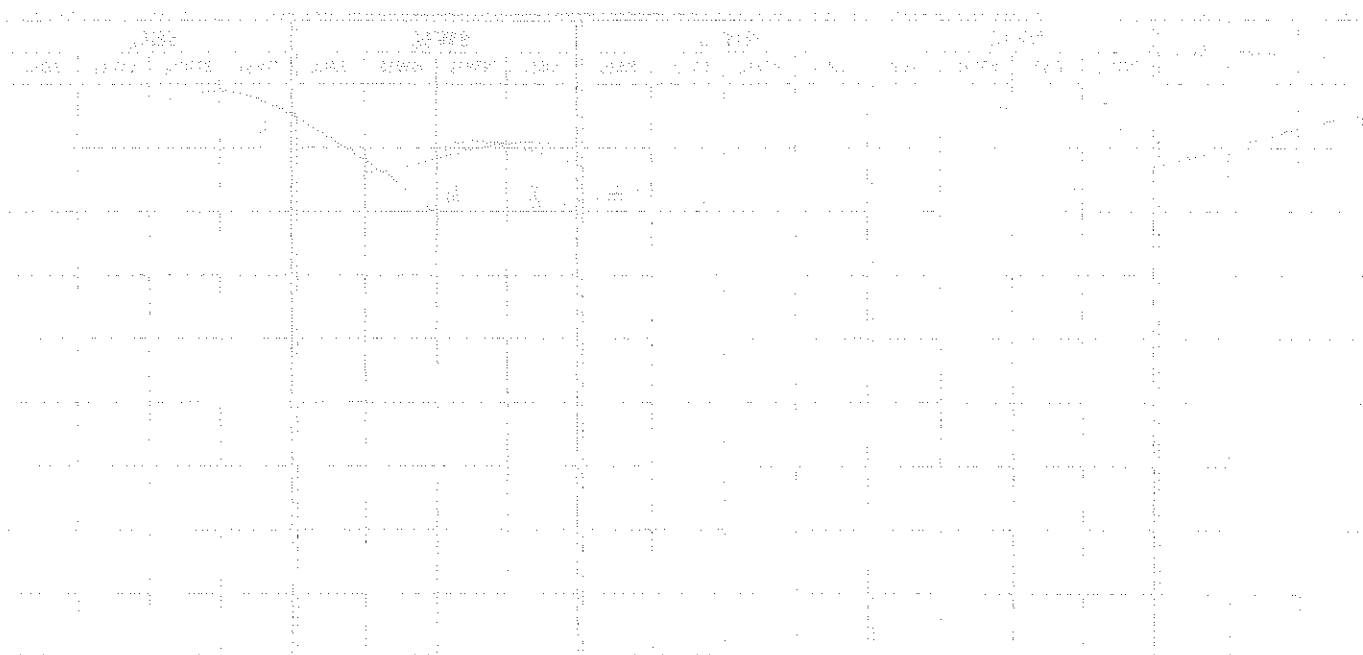

Some time ago you wrote regarding the future development of the Mossy Brae Water District and asked for information as to development of "Oswego Greens".

The Mossy Brae Water District has a perfected right for the appropriation of water from a well for group domestic use and this is restricted to use made when the right was completed in October, 1964. At the time of our final proof inspection water was used for thirty houses so if there is some development beyond this the Water District must file an application for a new permit if it is to establish a legal right for the expanded use.

I do not find any record of filing for the development you refer to as "Oswego Greens". If you could give us a detailed location I could give you the information you requested regarding the right for the development.


Gentlemen:


